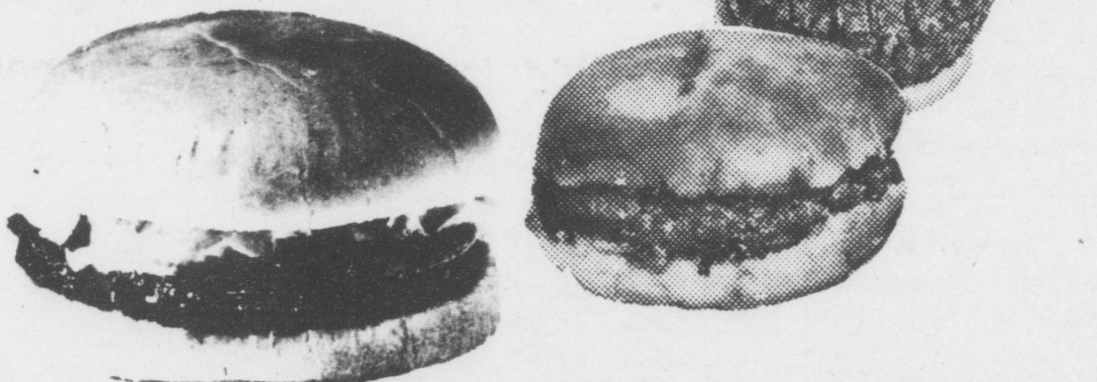
The bride is a graduate of Manheim Central High School.

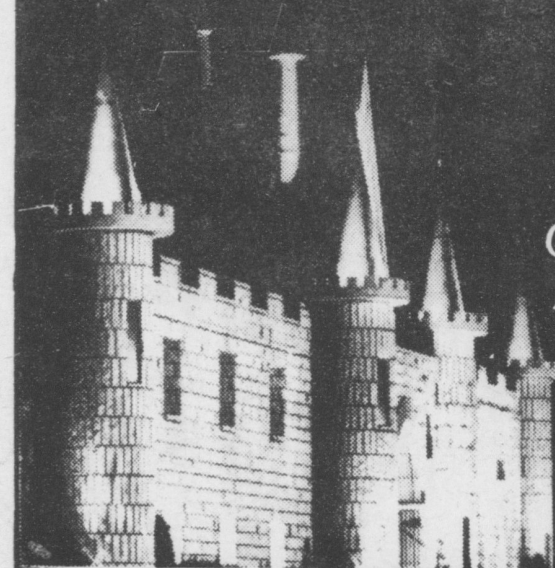
