Consumer protection

Occasionally, even the most carefully bought item needs to be serviced. Televisions go on the blink, automobiles break down, refrigerators suddenly don't work. Finding a reliable repairman isn't always easy, but here are some precautions you can take to help to ensure that you will get good service at a reasonable charge.

First, check if the product is still covered by a warranty. Check to see what is covered by the warranty.

If the warranty has expired, you may want to get estimates from three reputable and well-established repairmen.

Chose repairmen whose performance you or your friends have been happy with in the past.

It is often wise to get the estimates in writing. A written estimates should include: 1) Any minimum charges; 2) The cost of actual work to be performed; 3) A completion date; 4) An agreement that if additional work is required and the cost of repairs will go beyond the original estimate, you will be informed before the extra work is performed.

In getting an estimate try to avoid repairmen who would charge a large price for giving the estimate with the promise that this

charge will be deducted from the actual repair cost. This tactic penalizes you if you do not choose this serviceman.

After the work is completed, you should be given an itemized list of all parts replaced and repairs made. This way you can check what work actually was done.

If you are not satisfied with the work that was done and the repairman refuses to rectify the situation, you should get in touch with the Consumer Protection Commission, 900 E. King St., 299-7921, or the Better Business Bureau, 8 N. Queen Street, 291-1151.
