Mount Joy Borough Authority met last week and heard a presentation by C.C. Collings, investment bankers, asking to be considered for the sewer bond. No action was taken.

The Authority discussed the problem of the sink hole at well site #1 and gave borough manager Joe Bateman authority to repair it as soon as possible.

The Authority received a negative declaration from the E.P.A. They expect a grant offer by September 1.

They also discussed the proposed erection of a fence around the David Street standpipe. Vandalism has been a problem there. No decision was reached.
