Donegal Mutual Insurance Co. building new wing

Currently under construction is an 80 x 84 addition to the existing Donegal Mutual Insurance Building, Route 441, Marietta. Of complimentary design and size to the original structure, the East wing is anticipated to be completed in October. The new offices will house Casualty Claims Division on the first floor, records in the basement and rooms for expanding on the third.

Wickersham Inc., Lancaster, is the contractor for the three story addition and Bosco (Buckart) York, serve as engineers and architects.

Cost of the new construction is estimated to be \$750,000. When completed, the structure will include 57,000 square feet.

The original structure was built in 1961 having a west wing added in 1972.
