Mount Joy Historical Society to meet in remodelled church

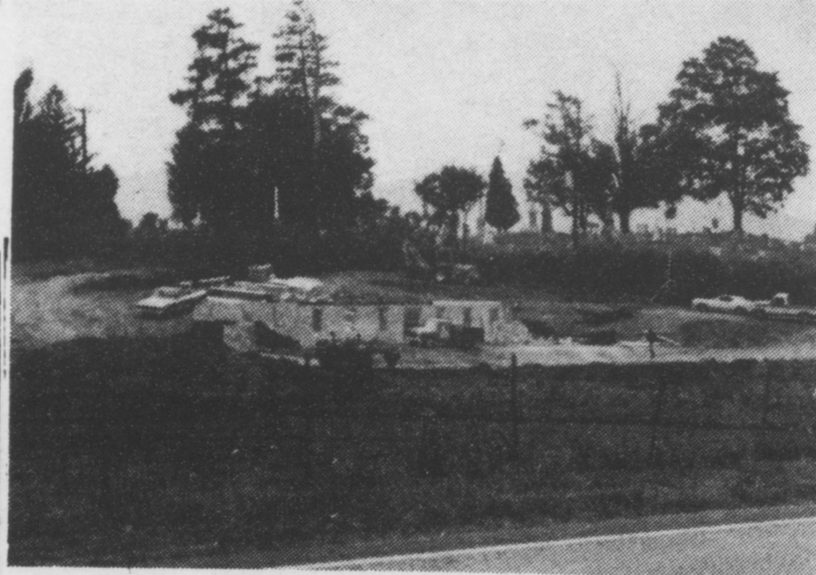

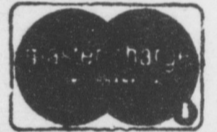
