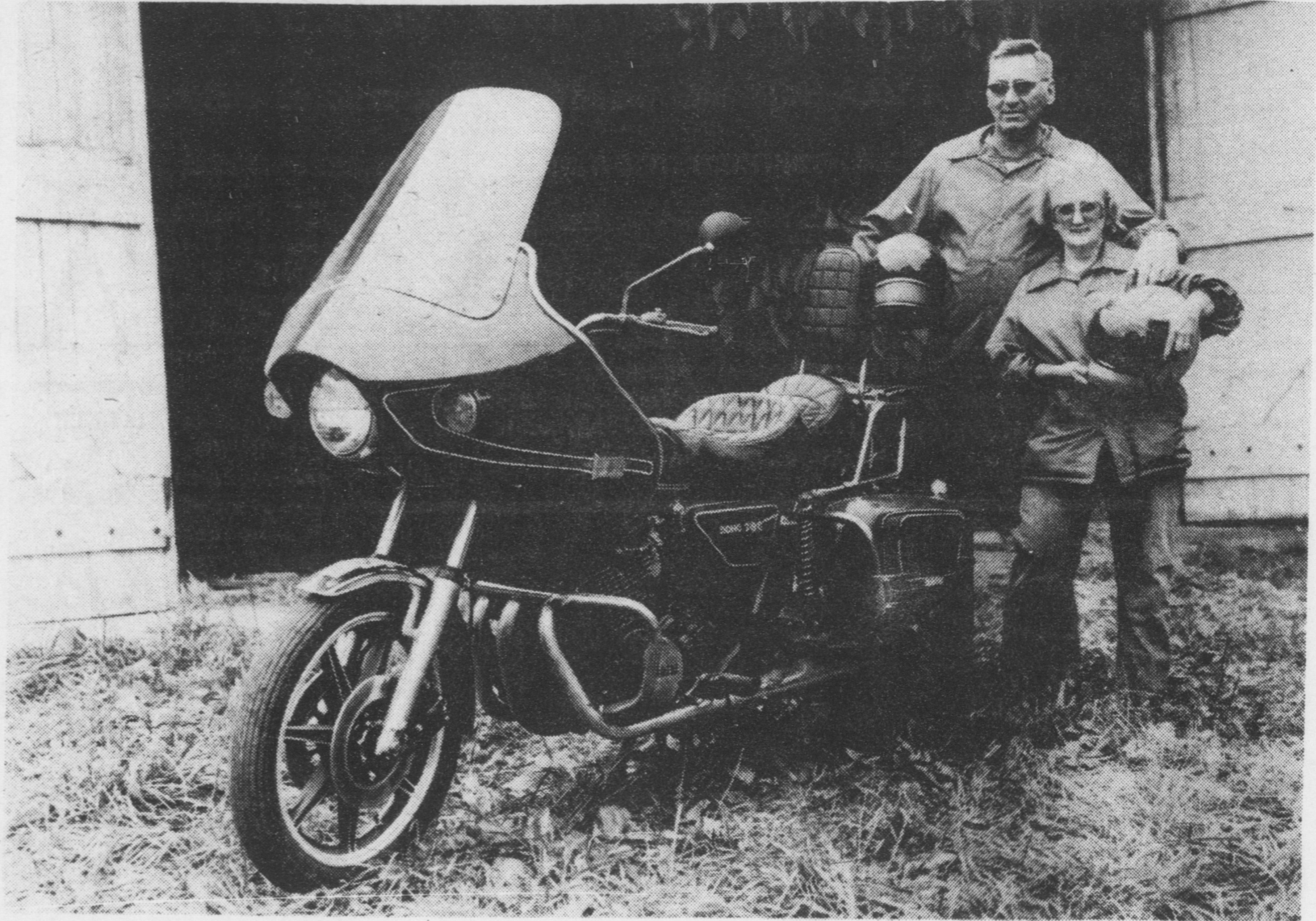

Injun Run

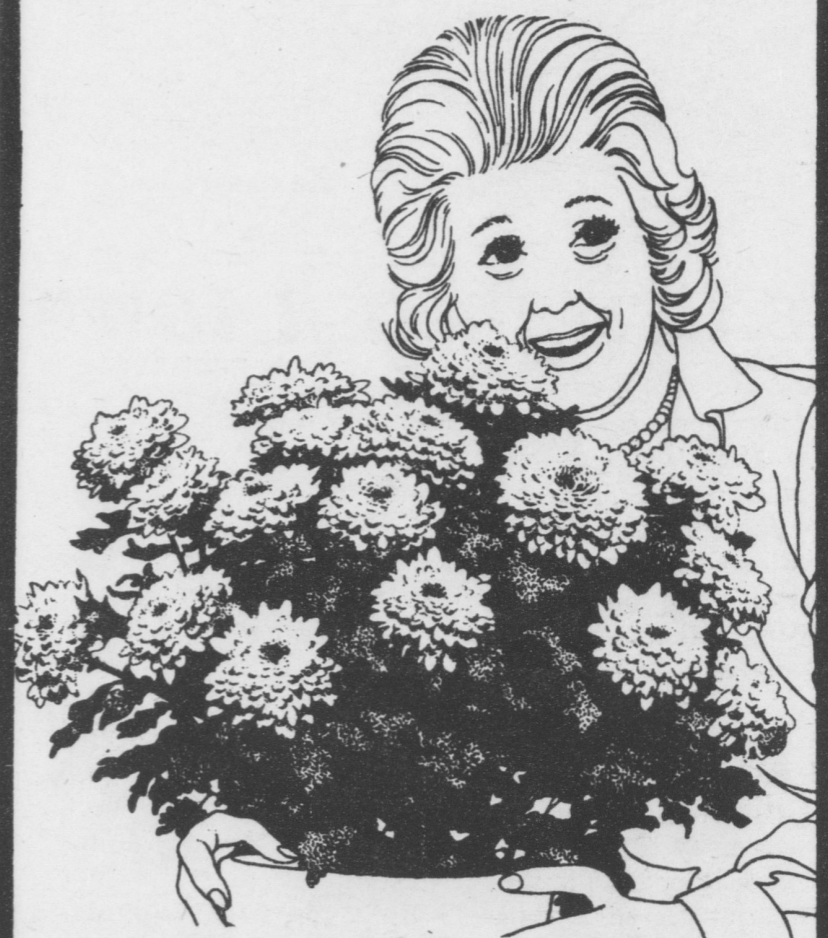
