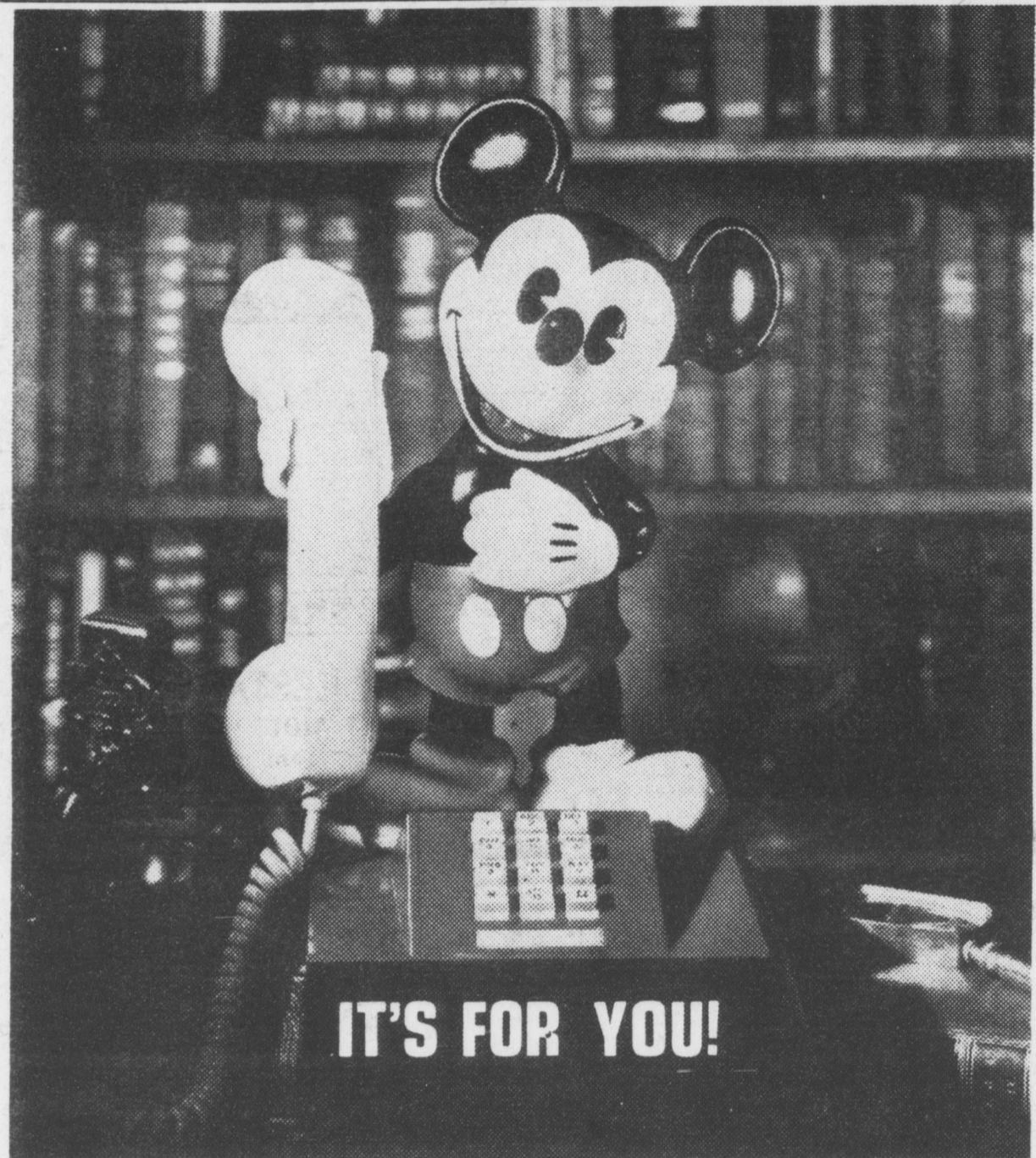
Sherman's Restaurant team is: Bob Garber, Claudette Lehman, Joe
