Viewer-voter show to be aired here

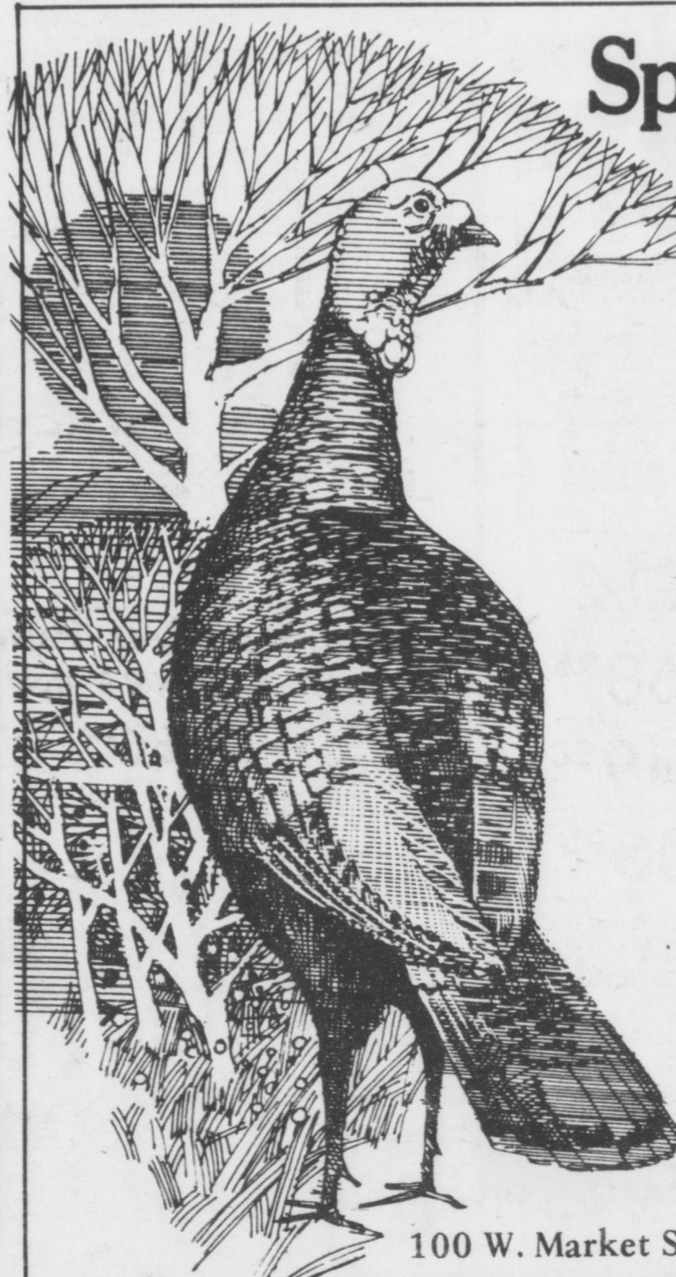
