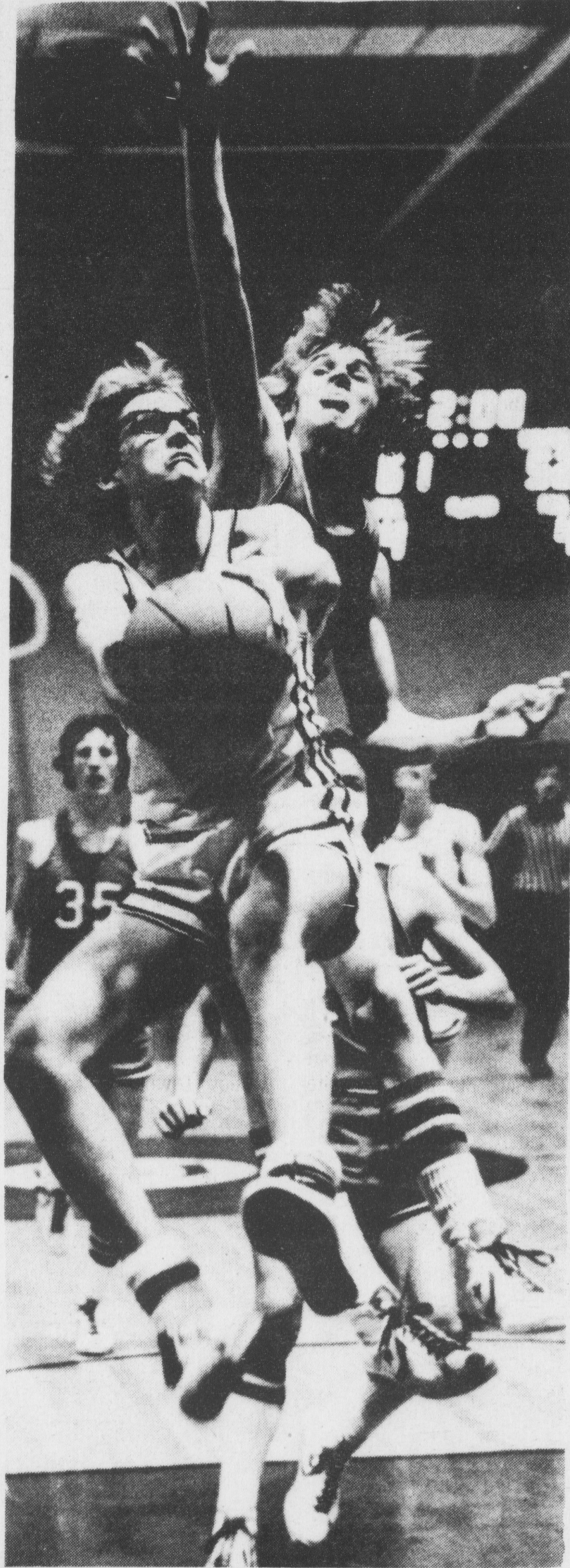


**Braves photos ready**
