
The band will play often during the performance.


## Model train show



Diller Miller is presenting his second annual Lionel train exhibit for the benefit of the American Cancer Society in the John Hoffman Solanco Fair Association Community Building, Quarryville, where it will be open to the public from Saturday, December 25, through Saturday, January 1, between the hours of 2 p.m. to 8 p.m.
