Christmas worship at St. Mark's Methodist

On Sunday, December 19, 1976, the 10:15 Worship Hour at St. Mark's United Methodist Church will be a celebration for children. Miss Sharon Givler, the congregation's Associate in Ministry, will bring a children's message; there will be both dedication and baptism of infants; the Pastor, W. Richard Kohler, will address himself to the theme, "The Murder of Innocence." A special feature of this service will be the bringing in, by members of the congregation, of layette sets and baby clothing for shipment to poor children, around the world. This will be done through Church World Service. The Chancel Choir will provide the music for the day singing "From Heaven Above" by Praetorius, the Slovak Carol, "Christmas Gather Round," and Mueller's "Create in Me a Clean

Heart, O God." In the evening of the 19th, the youth of St. Mark's Church will present the three-act play, "Bethlehem Alley." This production will be staged in the church's Fellowship Hall, beginning at 7 p.m. On December 26th, the Sunday after Christmas, the Morning Worship Hour (10:15) will feature a ladies choral selection entitled, "We Christians May Rejoice Today" by Schalk. The entire Chancel Choir will sing two chorales from Bach's "Christmas Oratorio." They are "Break Forth, O Beuteous Heavenly Light" and "Thee with Tender Care I Cherish." The Pastor preaches on the theme, "A Faith for the Morning-After." The community is cordially invited to join with the membership of St. Mark's Church in these services in celebration of the Birth of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
