# Heritage Center open for free

The Heritage Center of Lancaster County will open its doors to the public at no charge on Saturday the 30th of December from 9:00 to 4:00.

Ordinarily the Center charges an admission fee, but for this one time anyone can go for free.

The Heritage Center contains many examples of Lancaster County art and craftsmanship: such as furniture, pewter, clocks, and coverlets.

It's located in the Old City Hall and Masonic Lodge buildings on Lancaster's Center Square.

Each ornmament is about two inches in diameter. covered with some sort of cloth, and has on the front the person's name, either stitched or shaped with stuck-in pins. On the back of each is a picture or word: "Merry Christmas," angels, a pipe, a pasted-on picture of a winter scene, "Noel," etc. The balls

were painstakingly, and

artistically, made by Gladys Rettew 'of Marietta, a friend of the Houseals. It took Gladys about two months to stick in the hundreds of fancy pins.

Each ball is different, although there are in the Houseal family 3 Jims, 2 Dicks, 2 Jeffs, 2 Kims, 2 Dennises, and 2 Bills.

This is the first time Mrs. Houseal has decorat-

ed her Christmas tree this way. She plans to make it a family tradition from now on. Most of the work is already done, so it will be easy if she can keep up with the new babies.
