Until his retirement in 1967, he worked for the Armstrong Cork Company. He was employed there for 26 years, and belonged to the company's activities association.

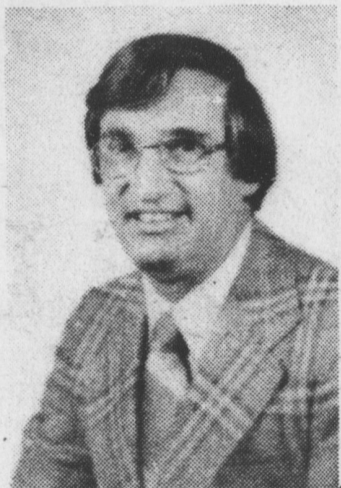
He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Maytown.
