Five Donegal High School students will be participating in this year's Southern District Chorus Festival which will be held on January 18, 19, and 20 at Pequea Valley High School.

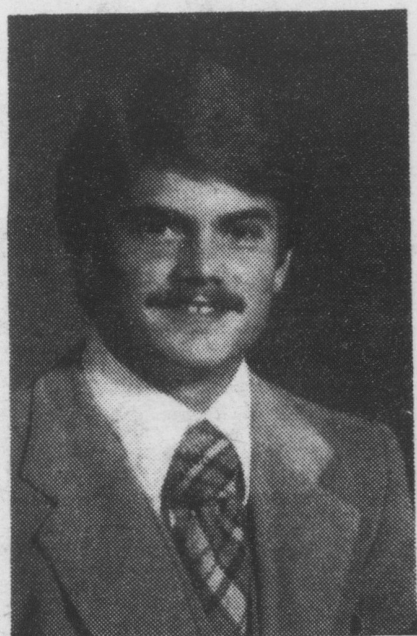

Robert J. Summers from the University of South Florida will be the guest conductor for the two hundred member chorus. Public performances will be held Friday and Saturday

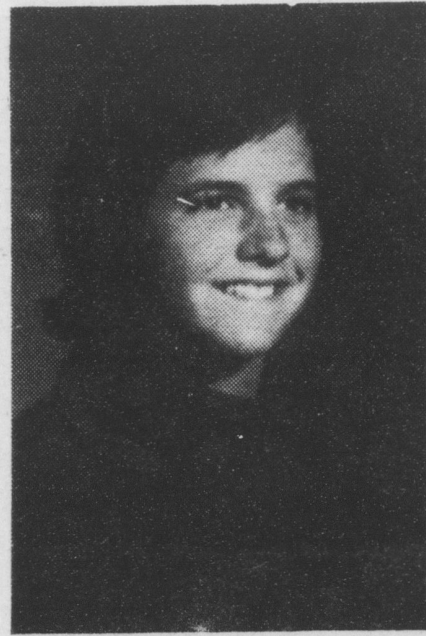
evenings beginning at 8:00. Tickets will be available at the door.

Mr. Peter Jarjisian, Pequea Valley's vocal

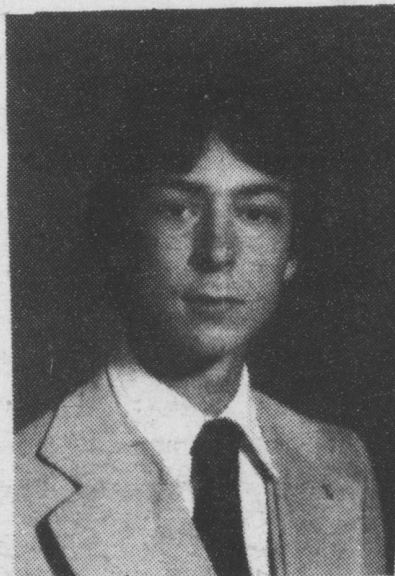
music director, is serving as host for this year's festival. Mr. RoAnn Lau is the vocal music director at Donegal.



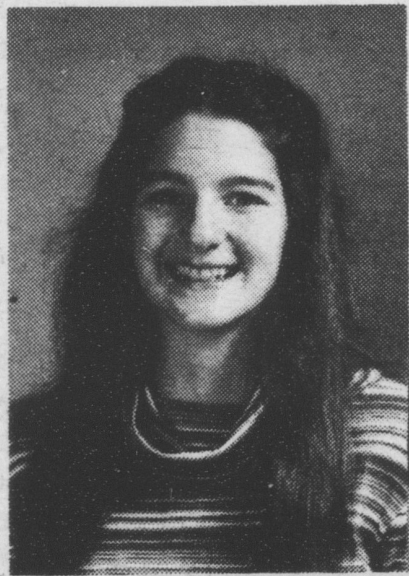

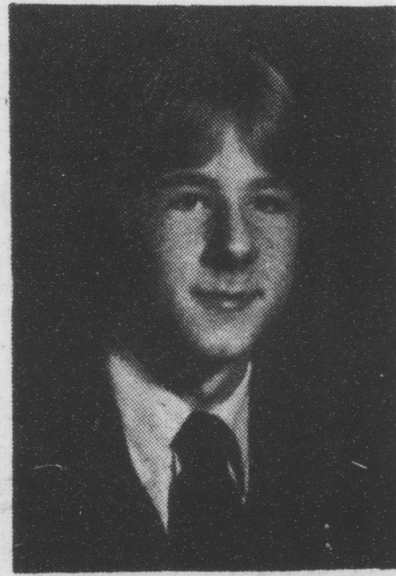
