In 1920 the U.S. Junior Chamber of Commerce was formed with 24 cities represented. It was not until 1951 that the Mount Joy Jaycees were formed. In 1965 the name was changed from the U.S. Junior Chamber of Commerce to the U.S. Jaycees.

Built on a solid foundation of creating opportunities for leadership training through community betterment projects, the Jaycees today, over 375,000 strong, are active in more than 8,800 communities in the United States alone.

will be celebrating this week through the following projects: the Inter-Church Council/Jaycee Community Prayer Breakfast which was held on January 13th was the kickoff to this year's celebration; on January 21st the Jaycees were in attendance at St. Mark's U.M. Children between the ages of 9 months and 3 years, whose parents have a Mount Joy mailing address, are eligible.

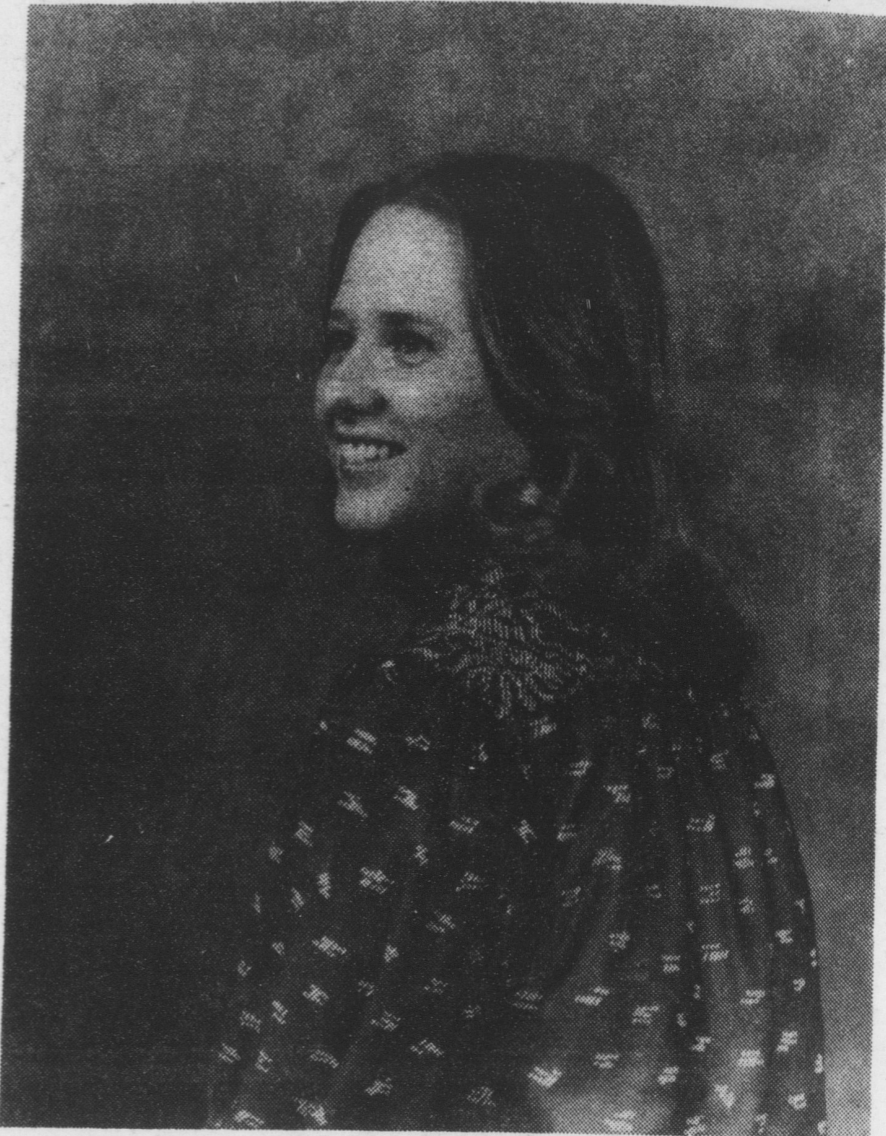
The contest starts on January 29th, when local residents begin to vote for their favorite child by placing money in canisters next to the pictures. Relatives and friends are

Due to falling prices for paper we, the Marietta Jaycees, have decided to discontinue collecting paper.


