

Donegal Students excel in Scholastic Art Show

Donegal students did very well in the Scholastic Art Show being held at Van Scriver's on West King St. in Lancaster. Thirty-two works by local students were selected for inclusion in the exhibit, which will run during regular store hours (including Mon., Weds., and Fri. evenings, plus Sunday afternoons) from now through March
