Maytown Ambulance report

The March meeting of the Maytown-East Donegal Township Ambulance Association was called to order by vice president Charles Schaffner. Minutes were read and approved.

The crew chief report was given by Sheila Doutrich in the absence of the crew chief. In the month of February the ambulance responded to 15 calls:

- 4 emergency calls
- 2 emergency calls for auto accidents
- 1 emergency call for a fire call
- 3 routine transports
- 3 routine covers for E-town
- 1 standby for Rheems
- 1 standby for Mount Joy at Donegal High School

The total number of people responding was 63 for an average number per call of 4.20 people. The total time spent on all calls was 92 hours and 32 minutes.

359 miles were traveled altogether.

Plans for Spring Bingo Night were finalized. Tickets were given to members to sell at a cost of ten dollars. This entitles players to:

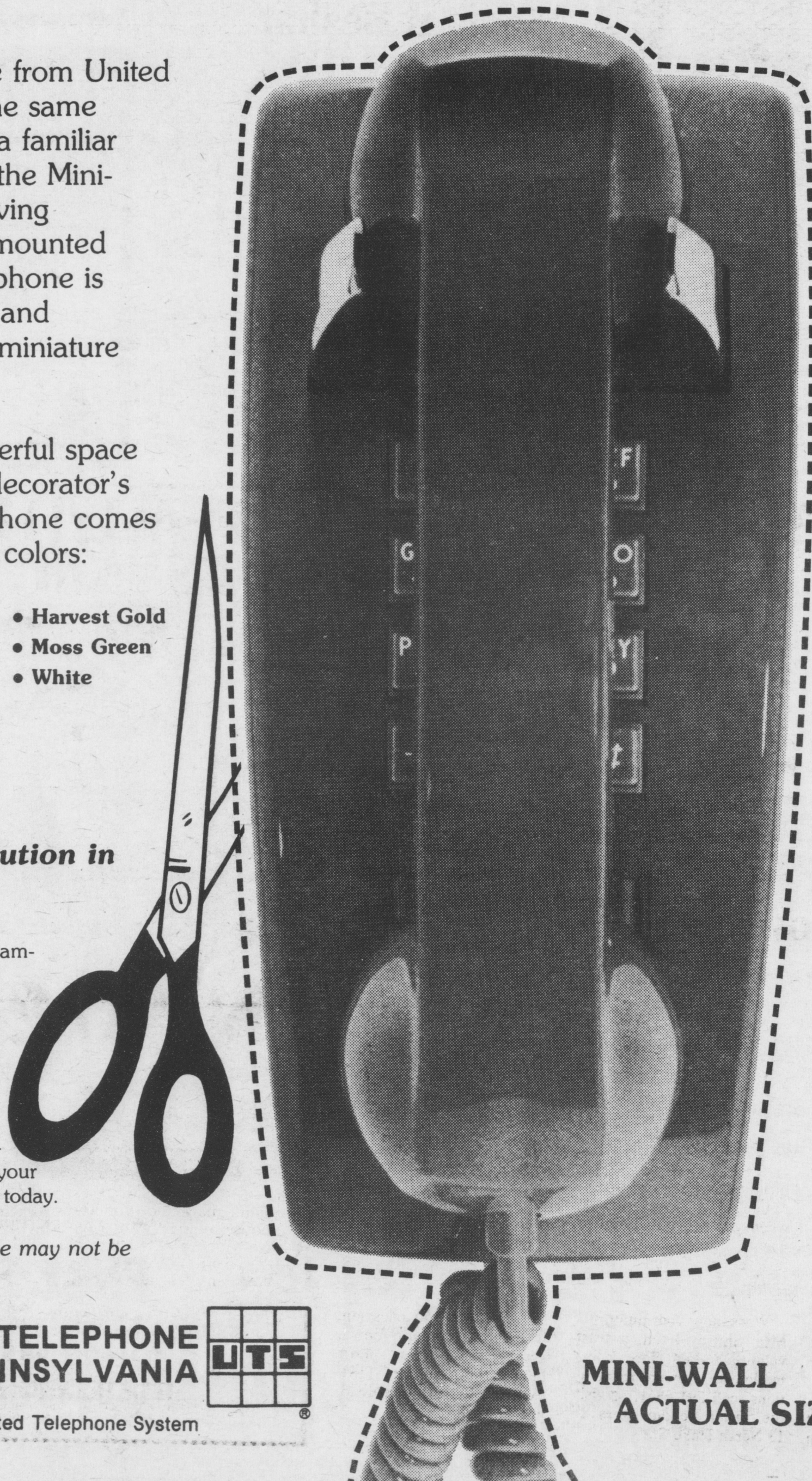
