

Did you ever participate in a bike-a-thon? Well, if you haven't, you've been missing out on a lot of fun!. Riding among one hundred bicyclists on a warm, Sunday afternoon in May can be "a high" you might never forget. And it's all for a good cause!

The Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation is sponsoring a bike-a-thon in Mount Joy on May 6, 1979, from 1:30-4:00 PM. Registration will begin at 1:00 PM in the Mount Joy Vo-Tech parking lot, the starting point of the two-mile course.

Prizes will be awarded to all who participate. Monetary prizes will be given for the following categories: Most Money Collected-1st. prize, \$25; 2nd prize, \$15; 3rd 'prize, \$10; Most sponsors-1st prize, \$10; 2nd prize, \$5; Most Miles Ridden-1st prize, \$10; 2nd

prize, \$5. Bike-a-thon Tee shirts will be given to all participants who collect \$25 or more in pledges. Those participants who collect under \$25 will receive a bike-a-thon iron-on decal. In order to qualify for a prize, money from pledges must be returned within ten days after the day of the event. Refreshments will be provided at Grandview, one of the sites along the course. All monetary prizes and refreshments have been benevolently donated by the Donegal Education Association.
