April 26-Grass & brush fire rear of building 9 Armstrong Ceiling, controlled burning on adjoining property.

April 26-Vehicle accident Rt. 743 & 441. Gas leaking.

April 29-Vehicle accident Rt. 23 and Long Lane. Assist to Maytown Ambulance.
