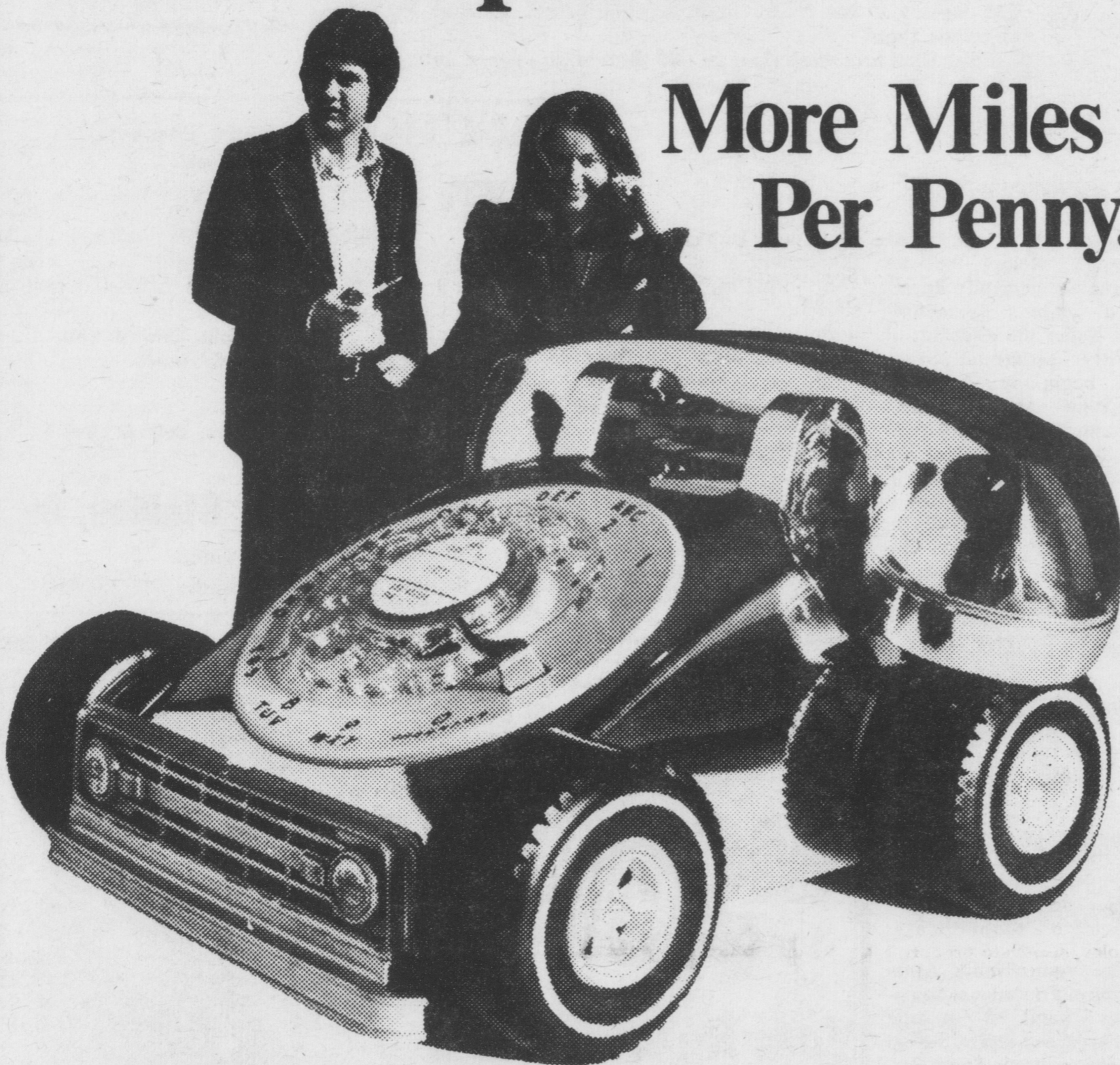
Summer volleyball

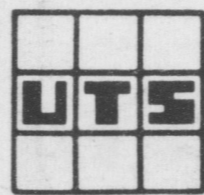

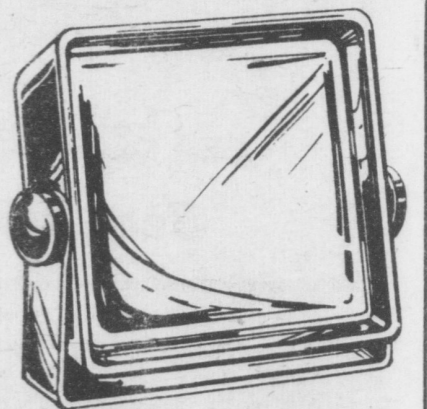
