## Schedule change

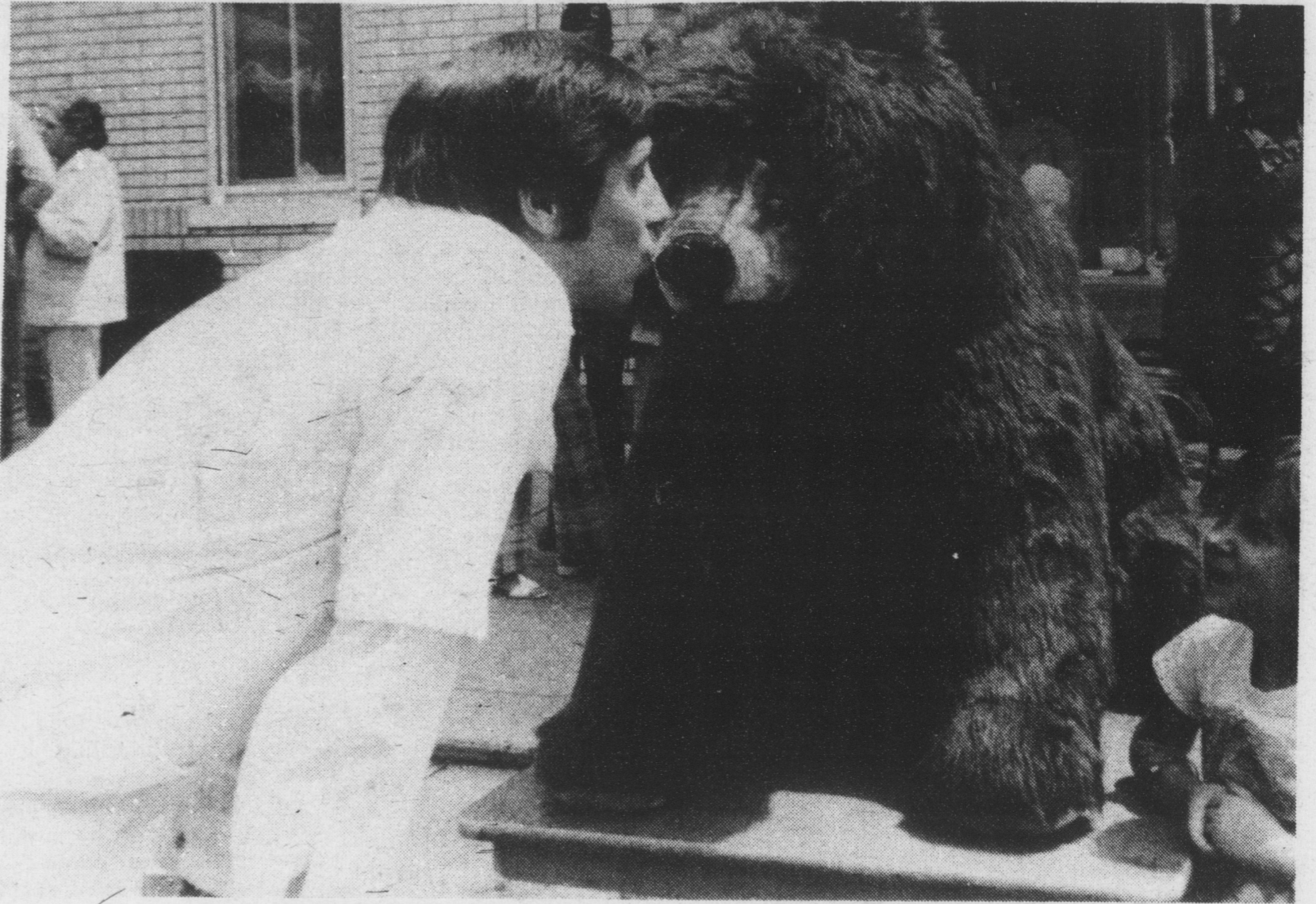
A change has been made for the June 11 meeting of the Marietta Auxiliary to the Columbia Hospital.
