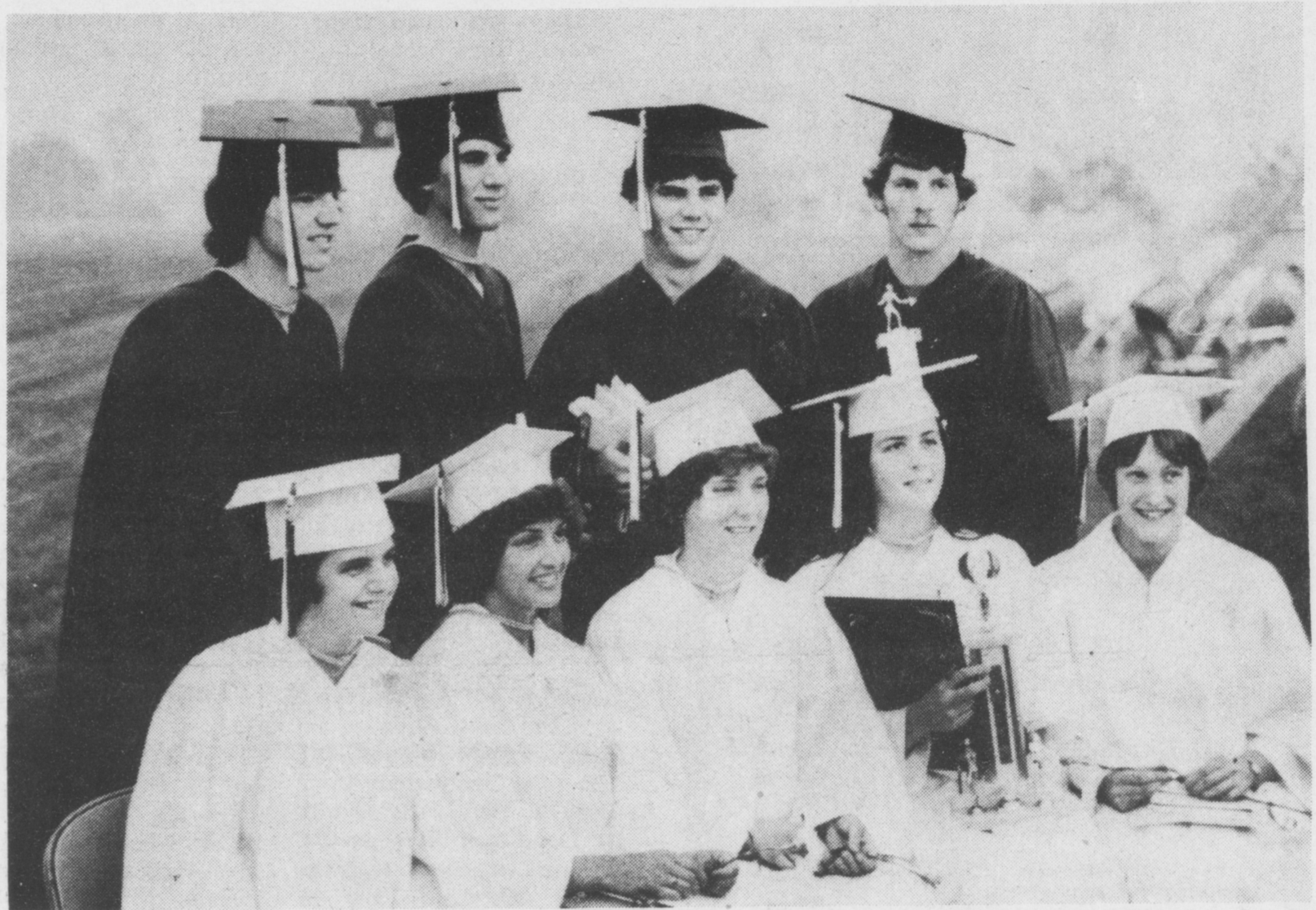

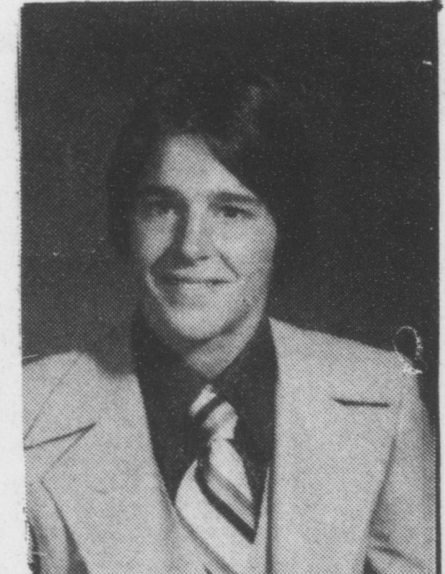
John Groff
