



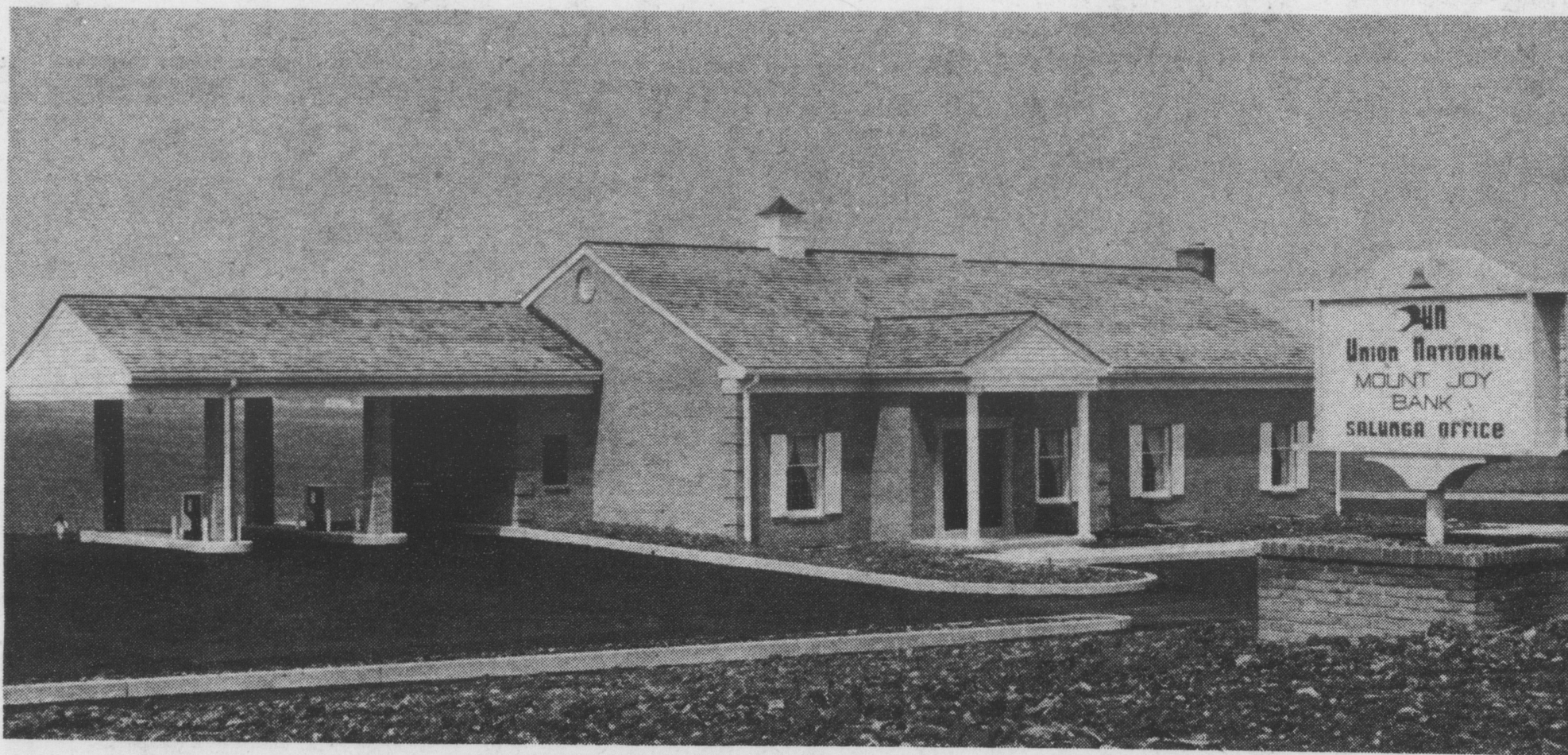

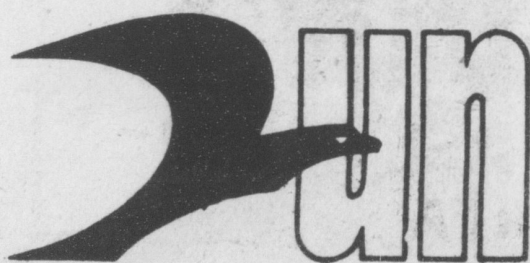

### Rocky Springs

Rocky Springs Park will celebrate its Grand Opening on Saturday, June 16th, with a hang-glider released from a hot air balloon, a display of fireworks, and a rock band.

The hang-glider is Roger Baker from Bethel, Vermont. He is one of only a few people in the country licensed to hang-glide out of a hot air balloon. The balloon, owned by Ken Marchuk from Ellensville, New York, will rise to fourteen thousand feet and then release the glider. Baker will perform aerobatic stunts including spirals and wing-overs on his way down to a landing in the park. The time of the performance will depend on weather conditions.

The fireworks display will begin at 9:00 PM.

There will be a multitude of old and new amusement park rides, lots of good food, canoe rides on the Conestoga and live music by the rock band "Hunter" on Saturday and the "West Philly Speed Boys" on Sunday.

Admission is \$4.50, which includes a booklet of tickets good for rides and food. Rocky Springs Park, at the end of South Duke Street in Lancaster, is open 10:00 to 10:00 daily.
