On a "Sentimental Journey" with Bill Dayton's band are: H. Morrell Shields of Columbia Avenue, Mount Joy, Donegal schools music instructor; Monte Cooper of Sixth Street, Columbia, a professional musician as

well as the owner of Cooper's Flooring; Phyllis Kraemer, a senior at E-town College where she is majoring in music; and Lancaster residents Ed Brabits and Merle Hildebrandt, both members of Bob Troxel's Band.

Pennsylvanians were influential in swing music. The Dorsey brothers, Fred Waring, Les Brown and Glen Miller all came from the coal regions.

Bill Dayton's band will tour Oregon, Illinois, Iowa, S. Dakota, Idaho, Nevada, Utah, Wyoming, Nebraska and Indiana, playing such favorites as "Begin the Beguine," "I'll Never Smile Again," and "Jumpin at the Woodside."

The regular members of the Bill Dayton band are from Maryland and south Pennsylvania. They appear regularly on radio.

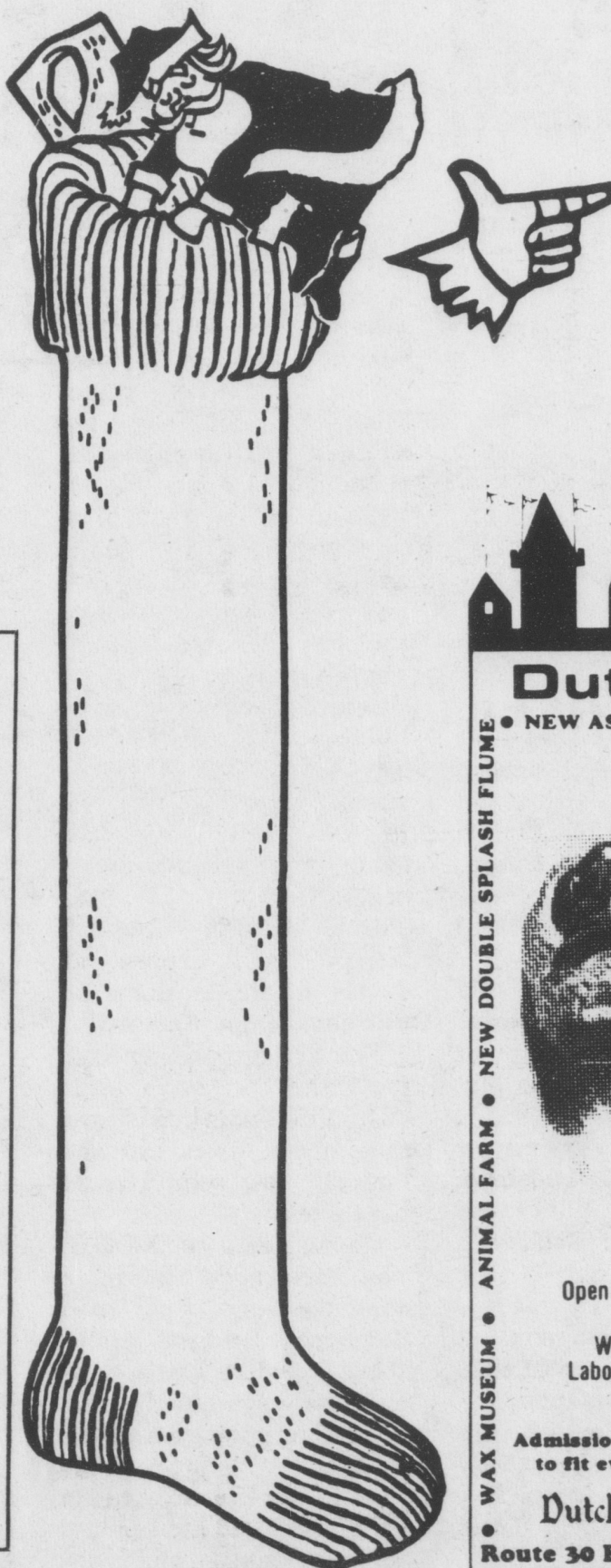
