Lancaster Ad Club**

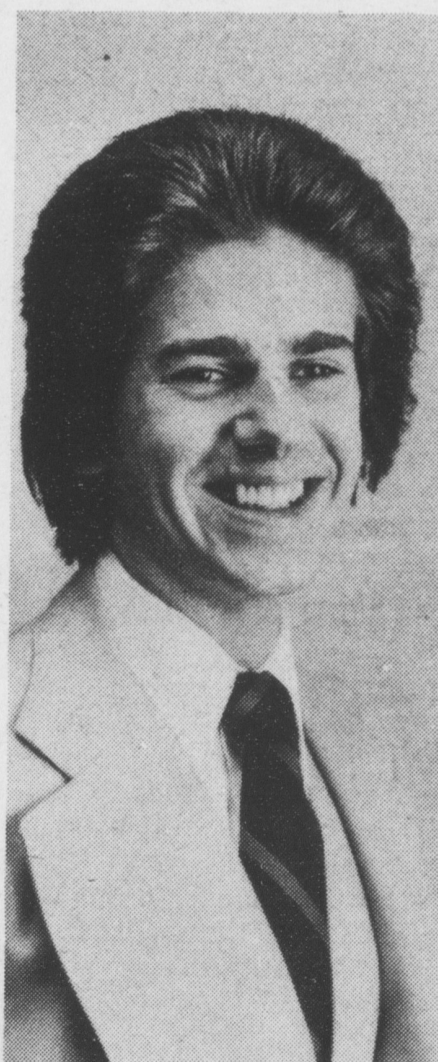
James M. Trimble, 407 W. Chestnut St., Lancaster, has been elected president of the Lancaster Advertising Club.
