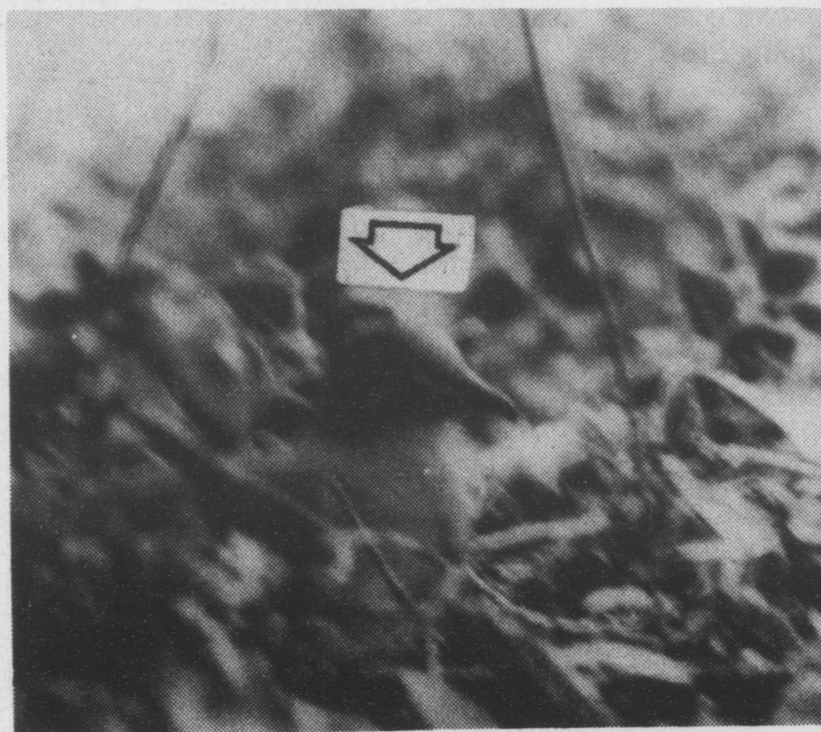
Since its inception the group has sung for many church and community functions as well as numerous homes, camp meetings at Mt. Gretna and Landisville, the Masonic
