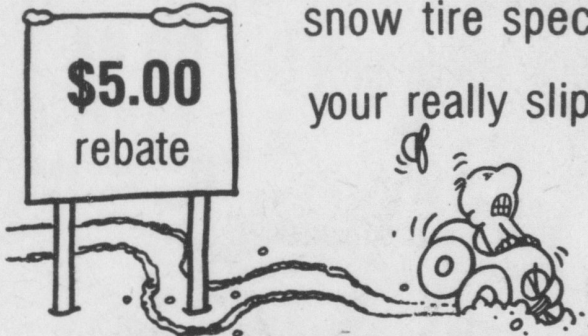

Bainbridge fall festival at winery on Sept. 15

Nissley Vineyards Winery will be the site of grape-stomping, wine drinking, organ playing, dancing, eating and apple bobbing on Saturday, Sept. 15th, from 4:00 to 9:00, when the Bainbridge Harvest Festival is held there.

All proceeds will go to benefit the Bainbridge Fire Company.

Admission will be only 50 cents.

Mount Joy folks who are good at navigating back roads can follow Donegal Springs Road all the way to its end—it forms a T-intersection with Bainbridge Road. Turn right at the T.

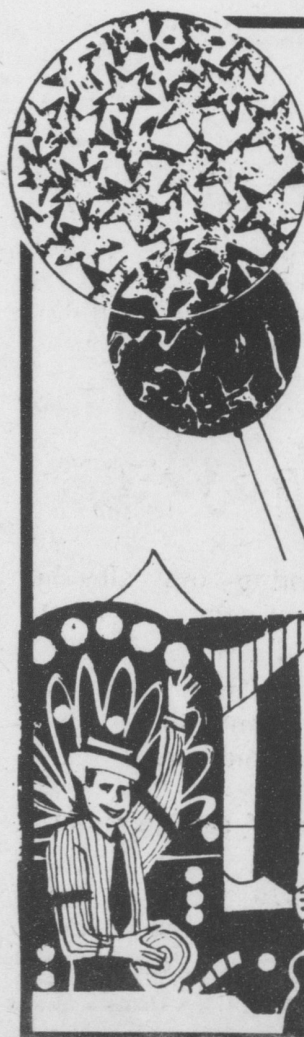
