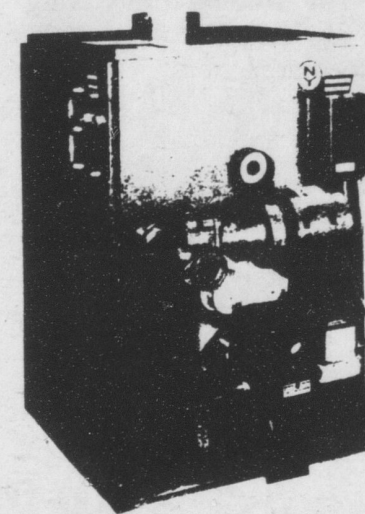
Volunteers are needed to teach sewing, academic skills, etc.; for transportation; and for other things. All volunteer work will be done in Lancaster.

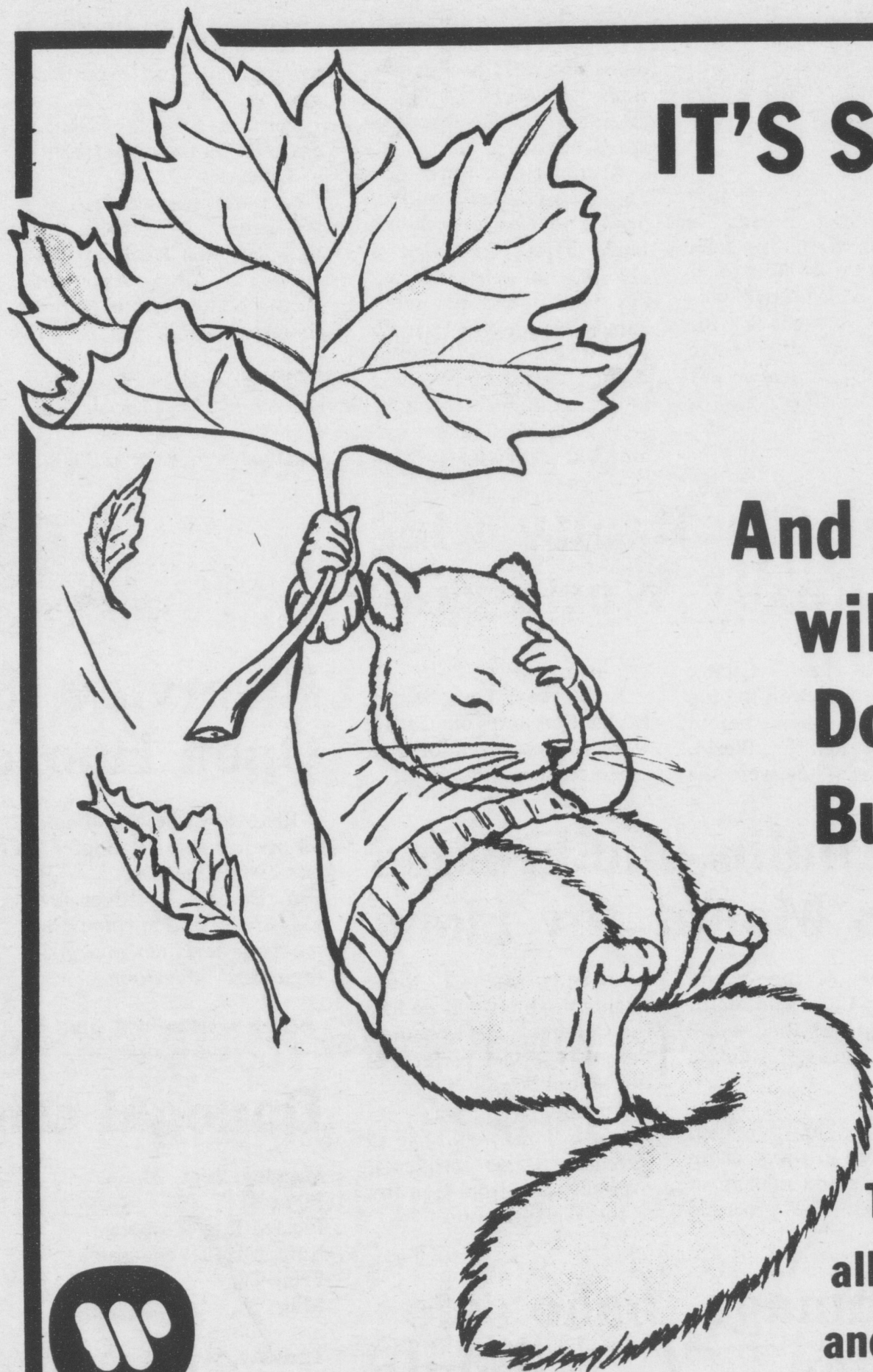

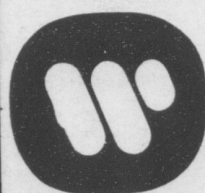
