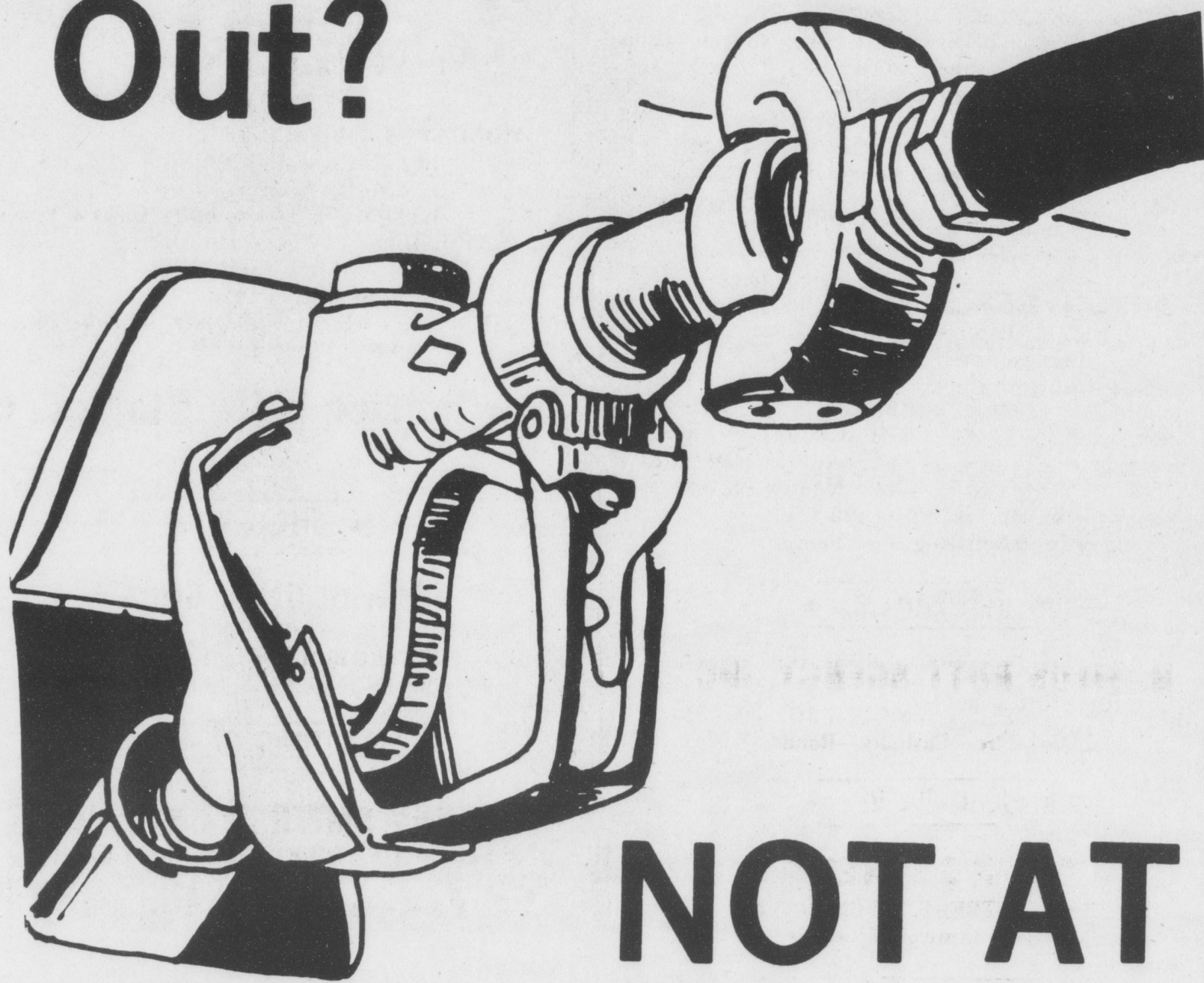
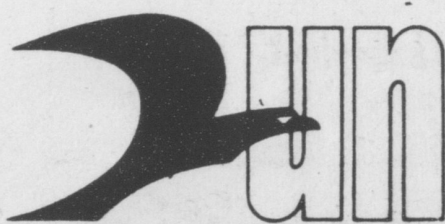

Solar energy publicist to speak in Lancaster

Environmentalist Barry Commoner will appear at F&M's Hensel Hall on Saturday, October 6, at 2:00 PM. His topic will be, "The Politics of Energy." He will discuss solutions to the energy crisis and nuclear vs. solar power.

He holds a Ph.D. in biology from Harvard, and has received six honorary degrees in science, and one

in law. He is now professor of environmental science at Washington University, and is chairman of the board of the Center for the Biology of Natural Systems. He has written six books.
