He worked for 42 years at Gerberich and Payne Shoe Co., retiring in 1970.

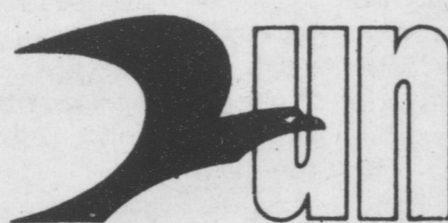
