Mount Joy Library celebrating 15th anniversary

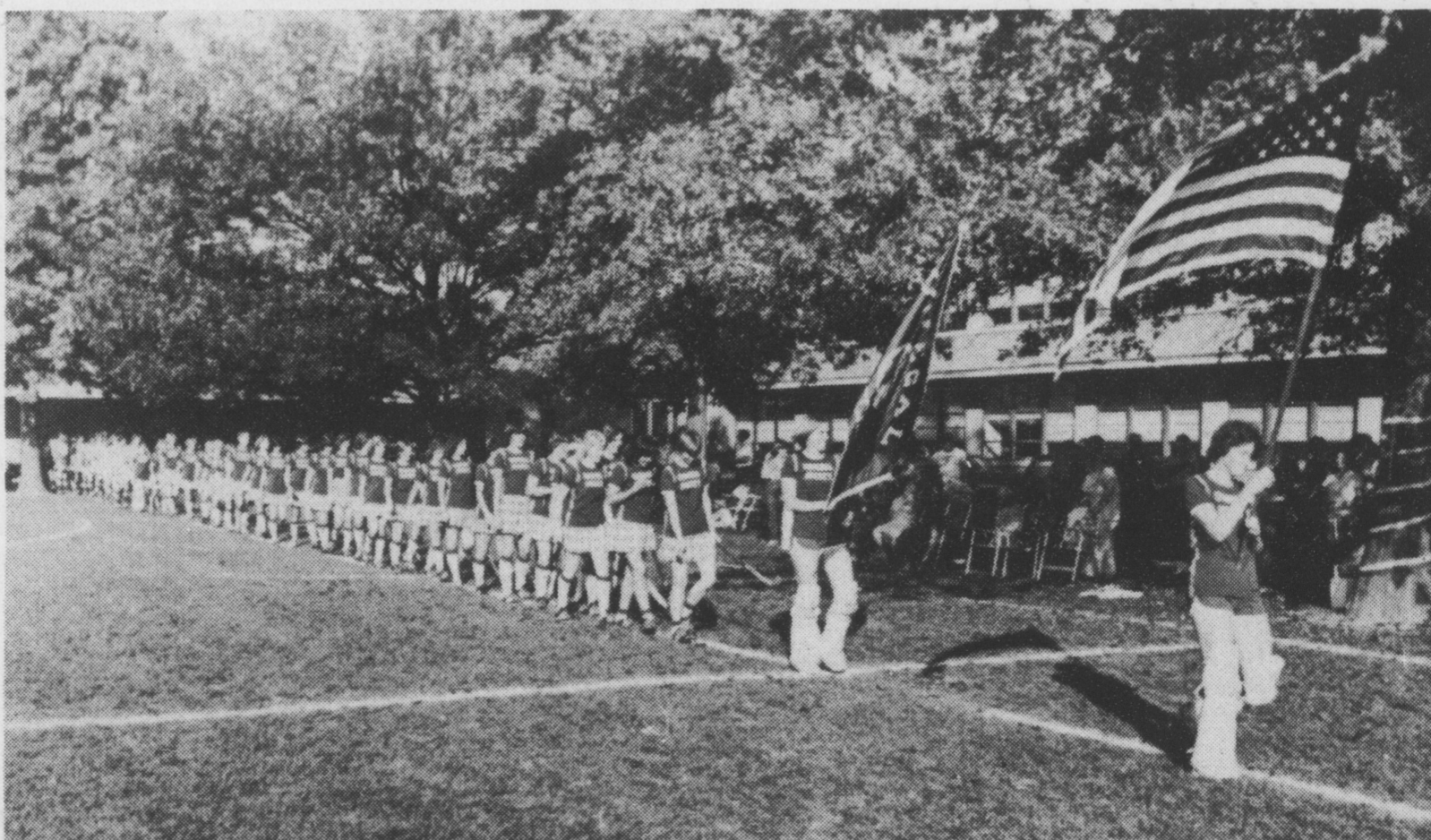
