The trees and electric lights that make the holiday season so beautiful can also make it the most dangerous time of year from the standpoint of fires. One of the first things every resident should consider is tree safety: what you put on the tree and where you place the tree itself. The cut tree should be as fresh as possible. A cut tree should be stored outside and placed in a bucket of water, after cutting about one inch off the end of the trunk for water absorption. Once the tree is brought inside, it should again be placed in water, away from doors, stairs, or passageways. It should be kept away from any direct source of heat, such as a fireplace. When the needles start to drop, it's time to remove the tree from your house, as at that time it's a pretty good fire hazard.

As far as tree decorations are concerned, Chief Shaffner says that all lights should be certified by the Underwriters Laboratories and "carry the "UL" seal.

Extra special care should be taken with Christmas candles. place Never candles on the trees, near curtains, or near any other flammable material.

Remember, electric lights marked for indoor use can't be used outdoors, but outdoor lights can be used indoors.
