This Thursday the wrestlers tangle with Cedar Crest there.



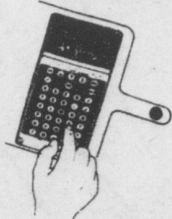

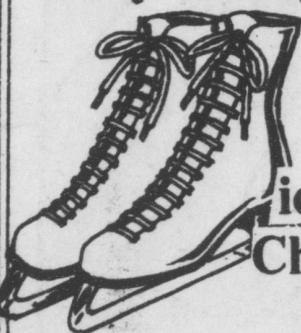

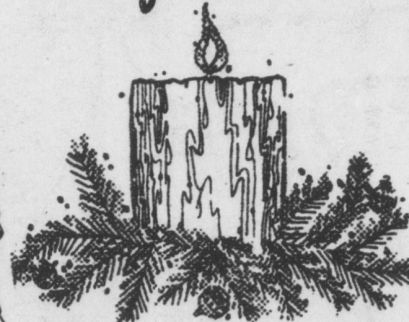
