1st, Jeffrey Suter; 2nd, Kirk Landis; 3rd, Christopher Augenstein.

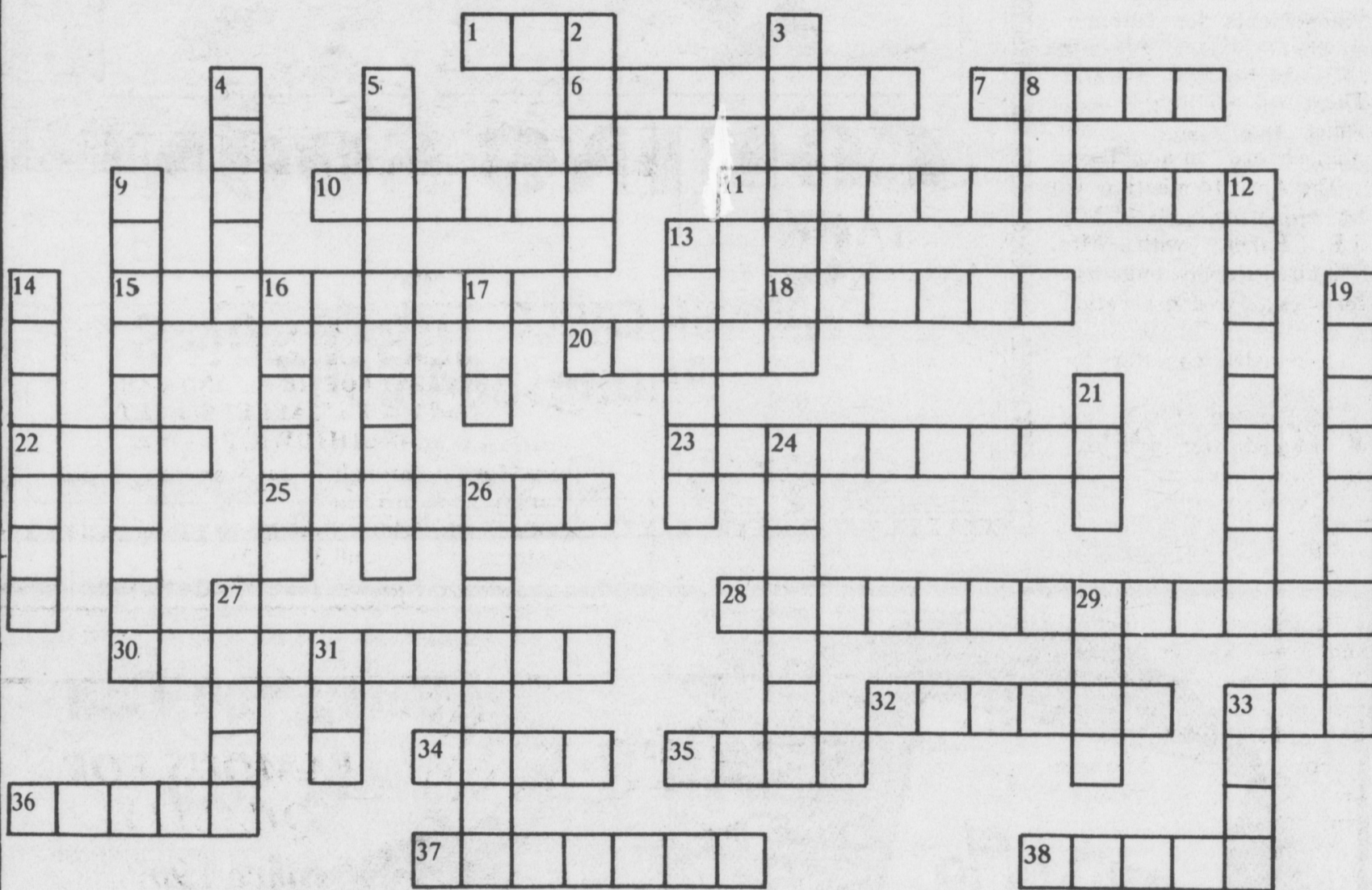
Adult Winner: Paul Suter.

This week's puzzle is for the rock music fan in the family. It contains the names of rock bands and groups.



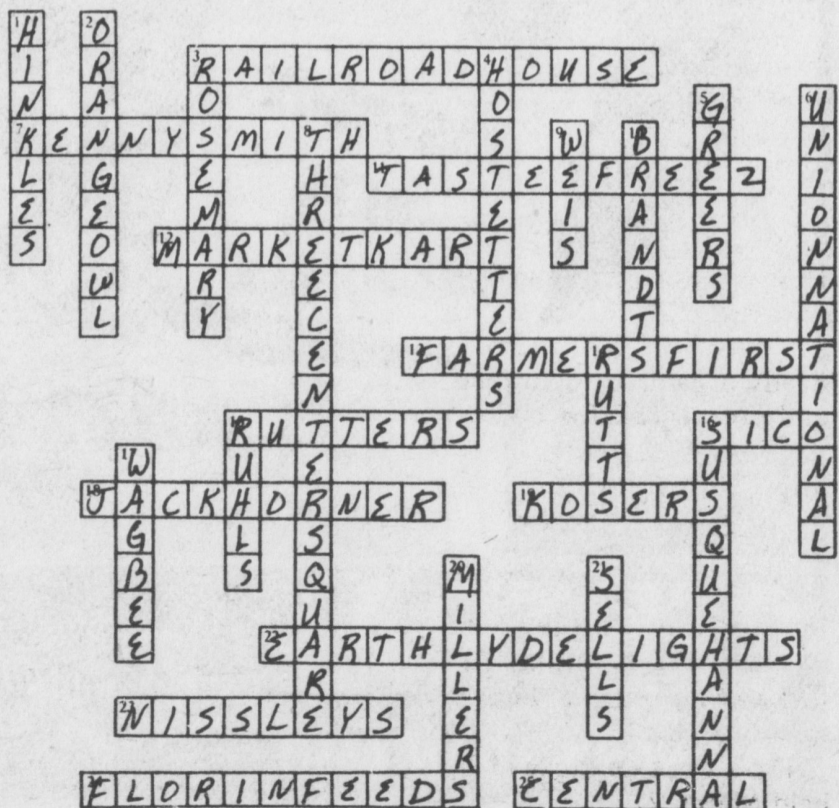

Kindergarten registration for the Donegal School District's 1980-81 school year will be held as follows: Grandview School—Tuesday, April 15; Maytown School—Wednesday, April 16;

Riverview School—Thursday, April 17; and Seiler School — Friday, April 18.

Registration hours will be between 8:30 am and 3:30 pm. Parents should register their child at the school nearest to their home. It is not necessary to bring the child to the registration center.

In order to be eligible for fall enrollment, the child must be five years old on or before September 3, 1980.

Documents proving birthdates and immunization records should be taken to the registration centers. The law states that no child will be allowed to enter school for the first time without a record of the required immunizations. Immunizations required for a child entering school are:

Diphtheria, 3 doses of toxoid; Tetanus, 3 doses of toxoid;

Polio, 3 doses of trivalent oral vaccine;

Measles, 1 dose of vaccine or physician verified history of disease;

German Measles (Rubella), 1 dose of vaccine;

Mumps, Mumps vaccine is usually combined with measles and rubella vaccine.

Parents wishing to enroll a child in first grade who has had no previous kindergarten should contact Gene Newcomer at any of the elementary schools.

Additional information concerning kindergarten will be available at the registration centers.
