Mount Joy Diner. Persons interested in the raffle should call Mrs. Harnes at 653-2456.

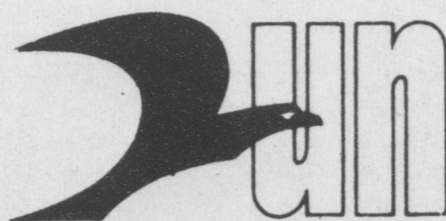
