Graham's mother, Mrs. Donna J. Smith, lives in Matown, and his father, Earl P. Graham, lives at Route 1, Washington Boro.

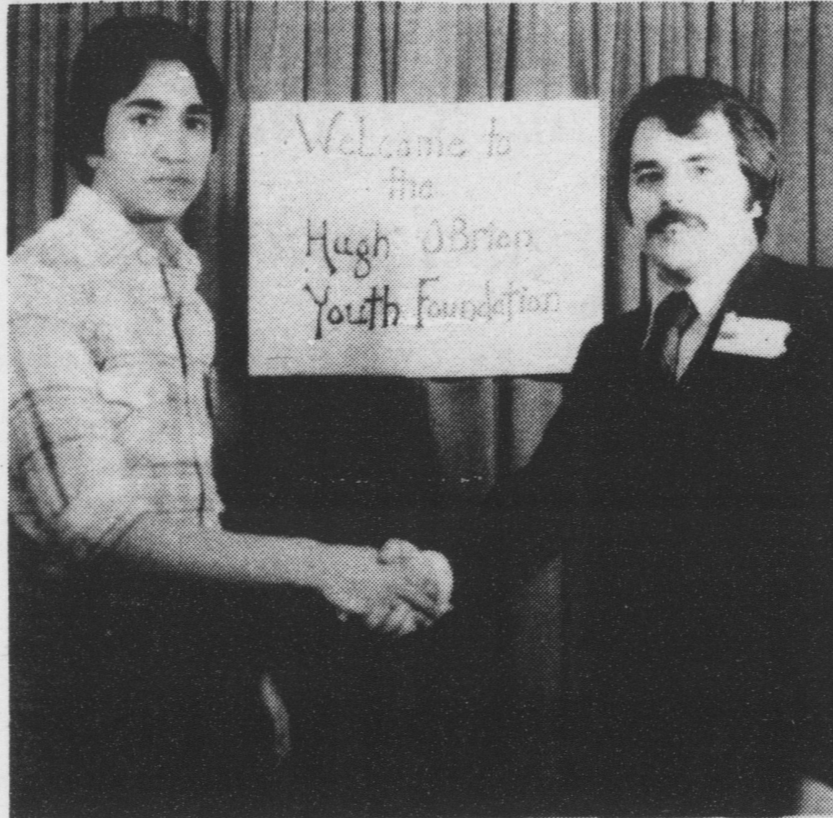

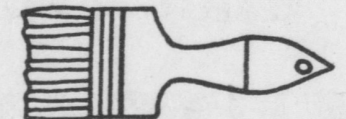
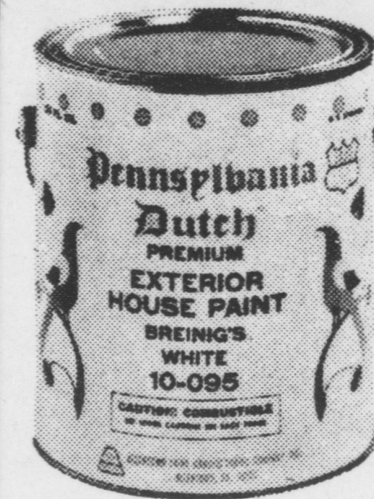
