An evening is being planned for dinner and the races at Penn National Race Track.

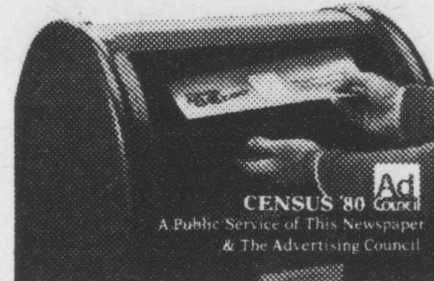
