

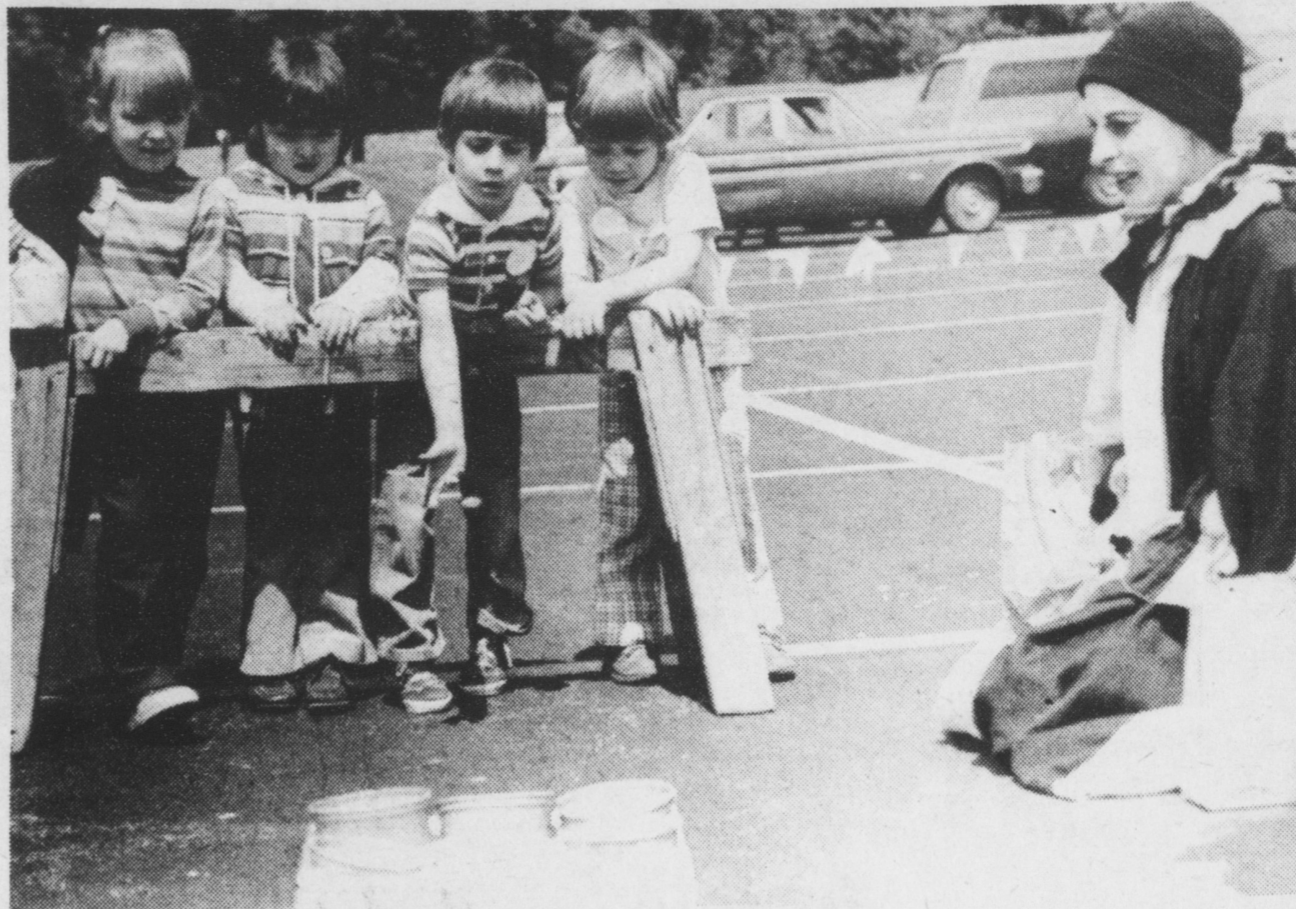

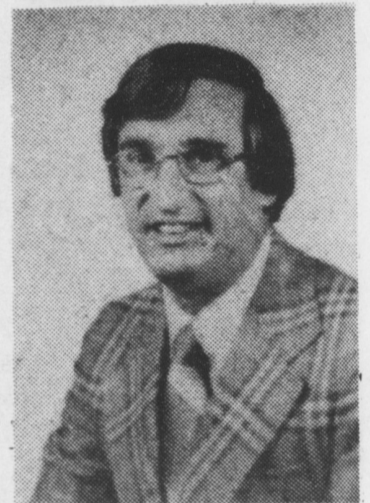

[continued from front page] Monday, May 26. The parade is scheduled to start moving at 11 a.m.

It will form at Riverview Elementary School at 10:30, and will proceed west on Market St. to Gay, then north on Gay St. to the cemetery, where special services will be held.

Rev. Elizabeth Iseminger, pastor of the First United Methodist Church, Marietta, and the Ludwig Methodist Church, Bainbridge, will offer the invocation. Rev. A. Red, pastor of St. John's Episcopal Church, Marietta, will repeat the benediction.

Included in the line of march will be the DHS and Bainbridge Bands; the Columbia National Guard; Boy and Girl Scouts; the Marietta Youth Athletic Association coaches and baseball teams; borough officials;

police; and Mayor J. Robert Flanagan.

At the conclusion of the service in the cemetery, the parade marchers will retrace

their steps to the American Legion Home on S. Gay St., where all children who marched in the parade will receive a treat.

The Donegal Post #809 Auxiliary will sponsor its annual flea market which has been enlarged for this year's event.


