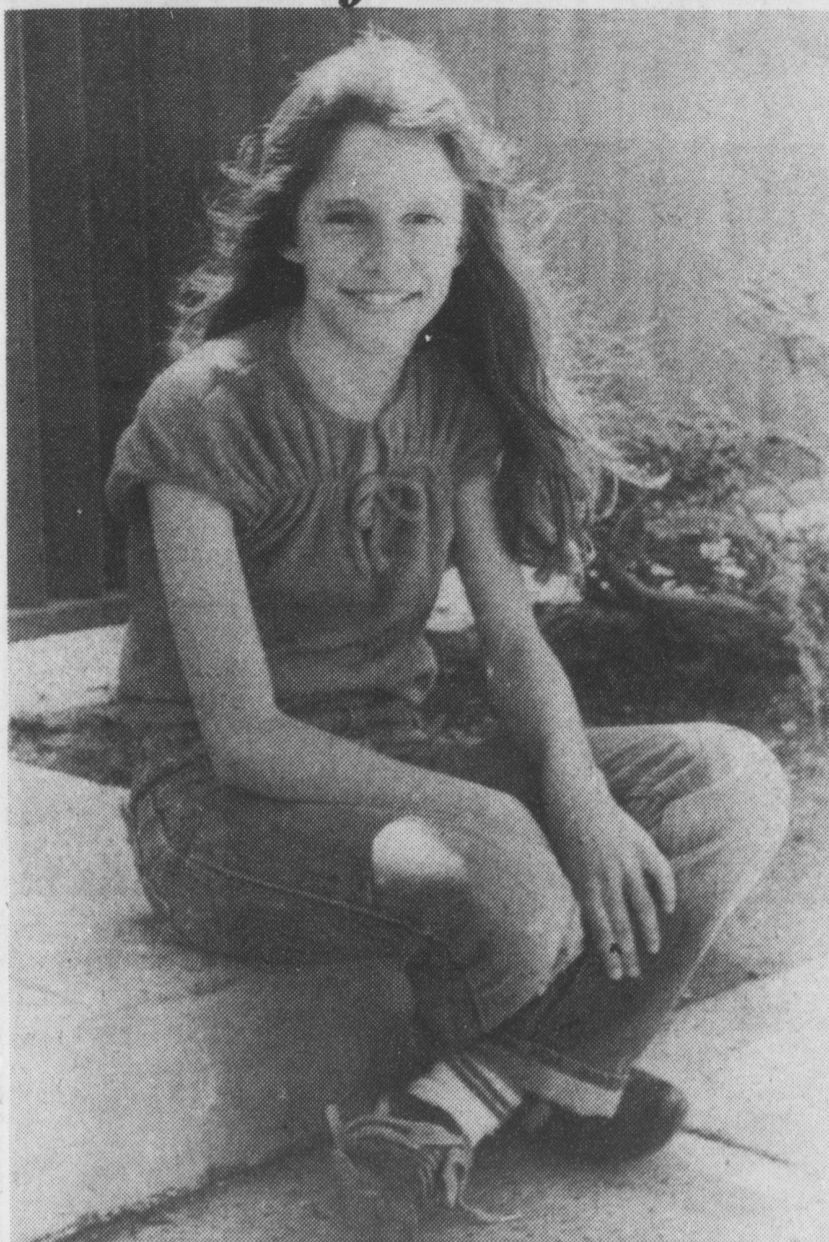


Guard of the Month
