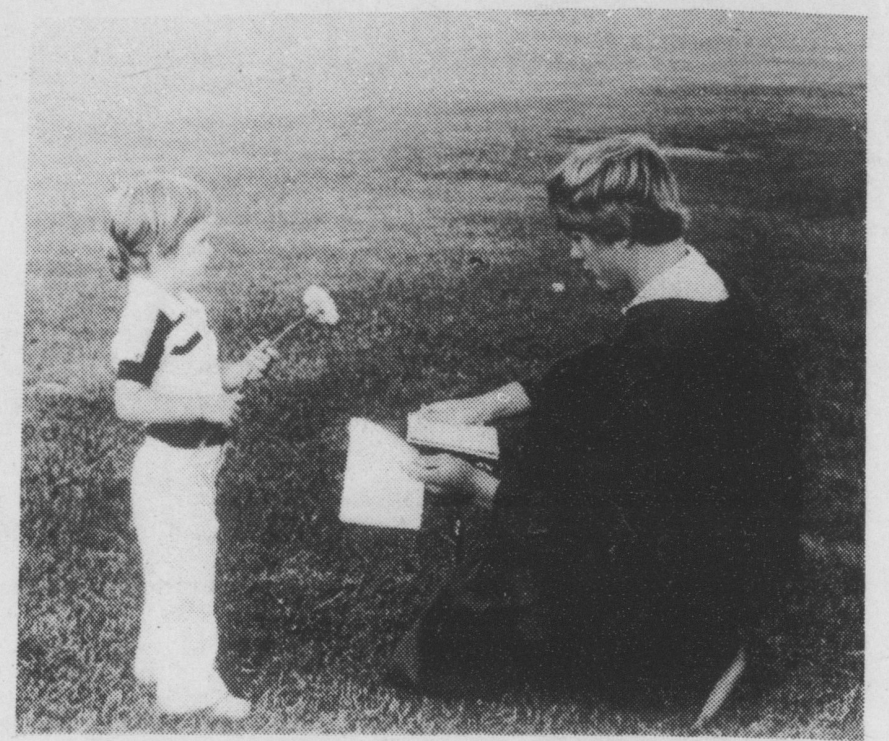


Brownie Troop 29 hosts a fun day

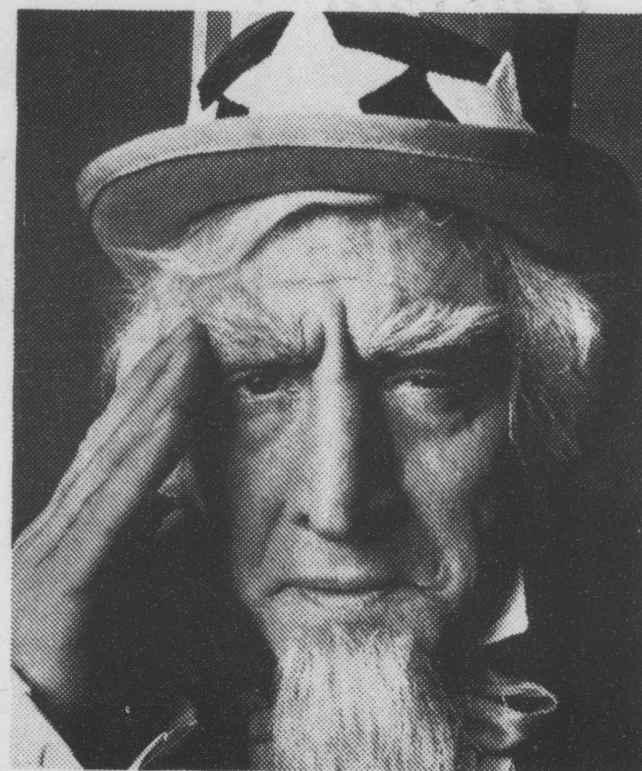

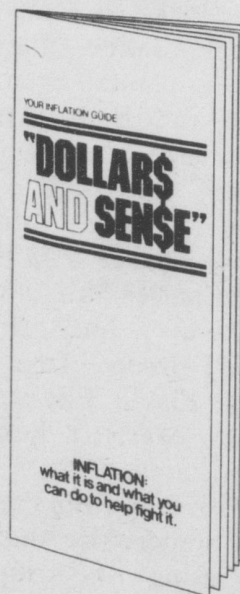
