Georgiann Westerman, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Neal Westerman, 28 North Jacob Street, Mount Joy.

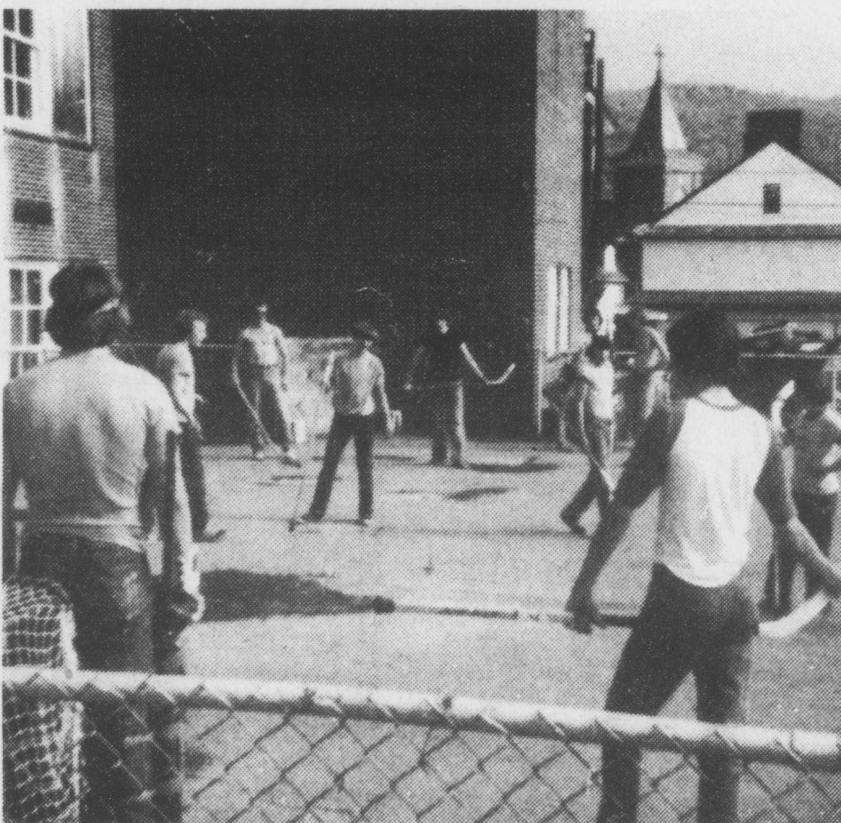
The following students are sponsored by the Mount Joy Legion:

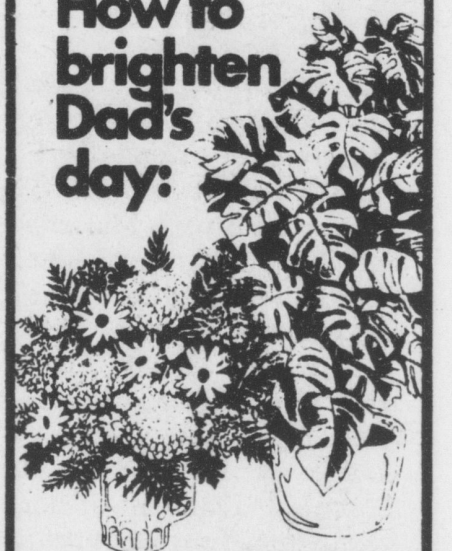
