June 29, Industrial false alarm at Lancaster Leaf Tobacco Co.

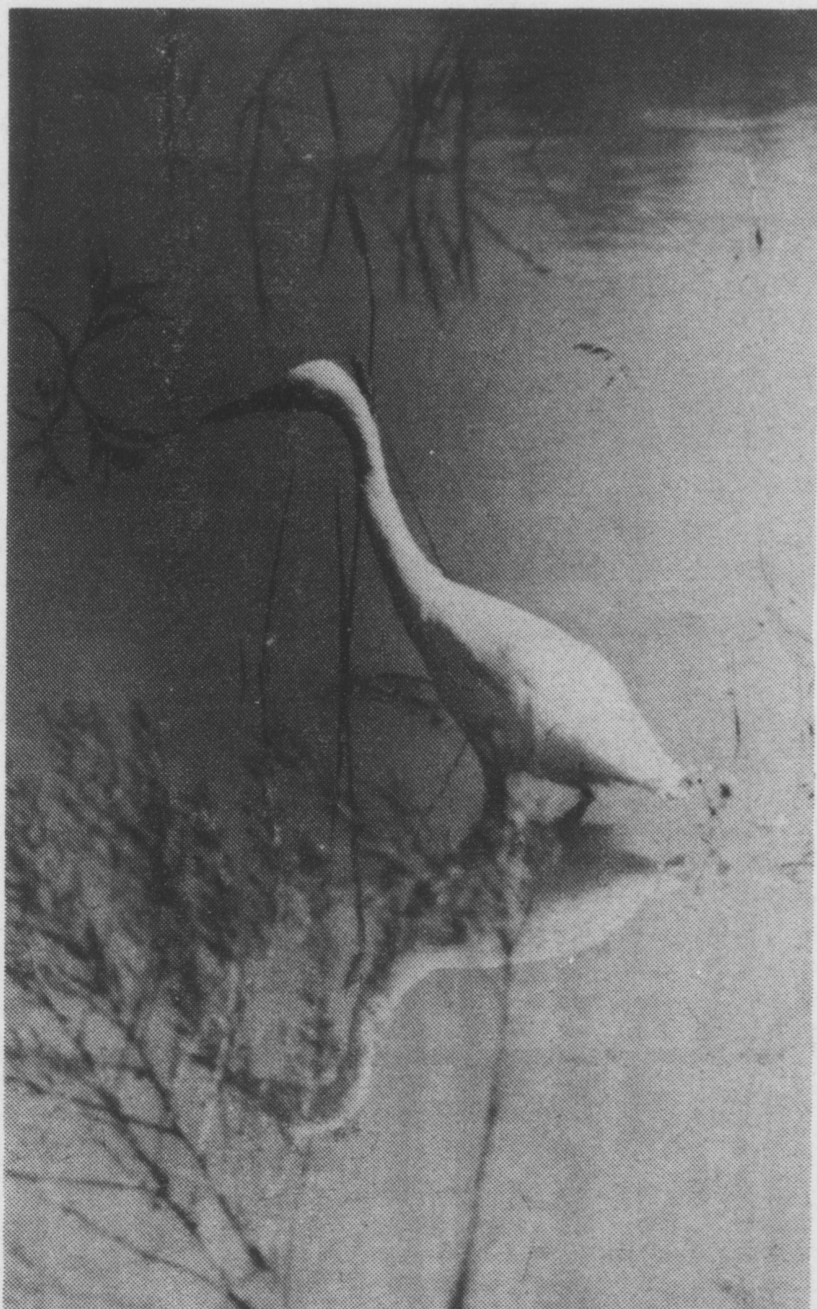
June 15, Vehicle accident at Rt. 230 and Esbenshade Road, rescue needed.
