

Susquehanna Times wins photo award


The Susquehanna Times was notified last week that a photo which had appeared on the front page of the Times on August 6 had been selected by a jury of members of the Yellow Journalism Guild as "the most unusual news photo of the year."

The photo, a picture of Ms. Nina Nellsen and Mrs. Victor Baer, was commended for its "Rembrandt-like chiaroscura, which allows the reader to use his imagination in filling in obscured details."

"In most new photos," said an unidentified member of the jury, "nothing is left to the reader's imagination. Every feature, every wrinkle of the subject's countenance is depicted in lurid clarity. The reader is treated as a passive observer of stark reality.

"Not so in the Times picture," the jury member went on. "It is safe to say that every reader looking at the Times photo is free to create his own images of Ms. Nellson and Mrs. Baer.

"The Times photo is a courageous challenge to the reader to stop trusting photo-journalism and to revive his own creative power and paint his own subjective pictures of Ms. Ellson and Mrs. Baer."
