resides therein with a resides therein with no children," if granted a special exception by the zoning hearing board, in a general commercial zone.
There were several stipulations in Friday's decision, including, for safety of the residents, sidewalks which will have to be installed by the developer along the front of the complex up to the end of the existing the end of the existing bridged area over Chiques Creek.
