Borough Zoning Hearing Board at last Friday night's meeting.

Regency Apartments, a Greenburg Associates project, calls for a 48-unit complex for the elderly to be erected on a 5½ acre tract of land between the Pennsylvania Power & Light Co. sub-station and Newcomer Road on Route 230.

The proposal must still go before the borough planning commission and the borough council.

Mount Joy borough council at last Monday's meeting amended the zoning ordinance allowing "senior citizen apartments where at least one of the occupants of each dwelling is over 55 and

resides therein with a spouse but with no children," if granted a special exception by the zoning hearing board, in a general commercial zone.

There were several stipulations in Friday's decision, including, for safety of the residents, sidewalks which will have to be installed by the developer along the front of the complex up to the end of the existing sidewalk, not including the bridged area over Chiques Creek.

Also granted was a variance on the size of the individual apartments in the Regency complex. Allowed will be a total of 694 square feet per unit, 106 square feet less than the ordinance requires.
