# Hello, Dolly! opens Sept. 26

The curtain will go up on the Columbia Little Theatre's production of **Hello, Dolly!**, Friday, September 26, at 8:00 pm. This first production of the 1980-81 season will also be performed September 27 and 30, and October 1, 2, 3, and 4 at 8:00 pm. A 2:00 pm show will also be presented Sunday, September 28. The well-known Broadway musical will be the Little Theatre's first major production in their new establishment—the State Theatre.

**Hello, Dolly!** follows the efforts of a widowed matchmaker, Dolly Levi, trying to catch the eye of Horace Vandergelder, the owner of a profitable feed store in Yonkers. The rich but miserly Vandergelder asks

Dolly to find him a wife, not realizing that Dolly plans to wed him herself. The fun begins when Dolly subtly cuts out all her competition, including Mrs. Irene Molloy, a hat-shop proprietor.

Janet Walker has been cast as Dolly, recreating the role she played for the Kiwanis production of the same show several years ago. Chet Zercher portrays the parsimonious Horace Vandergelder. Mr. Zercher has choreographed and acted in numerous productions at the Fulton Opera House and is owner and dance instructor at Dancer's Workshop in Lancaster. Vandergelder's chief clerk, Cornelius, will be played by Mike Helwig, Curly in last year's Little Theatre produc-

tion of **Oklahoma!** Sandra Heisey will act as Mrs. Irene Molloy, the proprietor of the hat shop, and Beth Kise will play Minnie Fay, her assistant. Brian Bartch will play Barnaby, Cornelius' young friend.

Other cast members include: Patti Fisher as Ermengarde; Joseph Lively as Ambrose; Rose Barr as Ernestina; Sylvester Devine as the Judge; Randy Rohrer as Rudolph; and Thelma Kreiser as Mrs. Rose.

The production is being directed by Duane Peters, with Mark Williams serving as music director. Jimmy Jackson will serve as lighting designer, Ron Haug has been named set designer, Patty Lynah will design costumes and Mariann Woehr will serve as choreographer.

Janice Shelly will be vocational speaker.

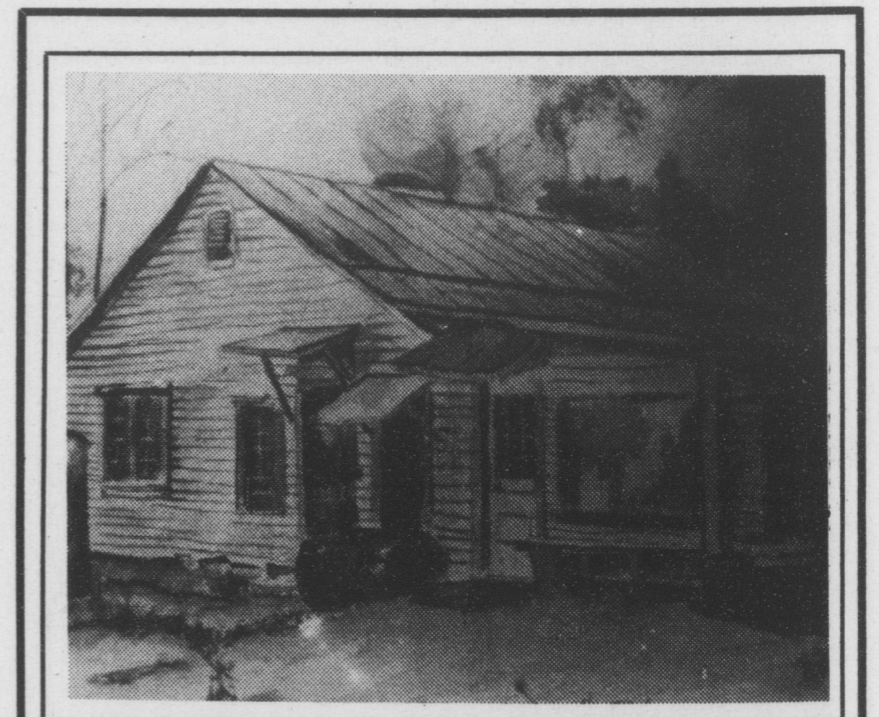
