The six African musicians, who come from four different African countries, represent Youth for Christ International. *Liberation's* program is intended to communicate the group's attitudes toward Christ. All six are skilled musicians and

use guitars, trumpet and electric rhythm box, along with their voices, to produce a smooth gospel sound. *Liberation* members are high school or college graduates and they are all experienced performers. Their music includes a few songs in African dialects, French and German, but is primarily in English, the only common language among the team members. The program is sponsored by Missions Prayer Fellowship of the church.

Following is the agenda for the meeting:

1. A report from Dr. Sherr on planning for EMR and LD classes this year at the secondary level;
2. Personnel matters, including staff recommendations, transfers, requests for leave, coaching recommendations, non - pro-

fessional recommendations, etc.;
