Meetings are always open to the public and to friends, guests and prospective members of the organization.

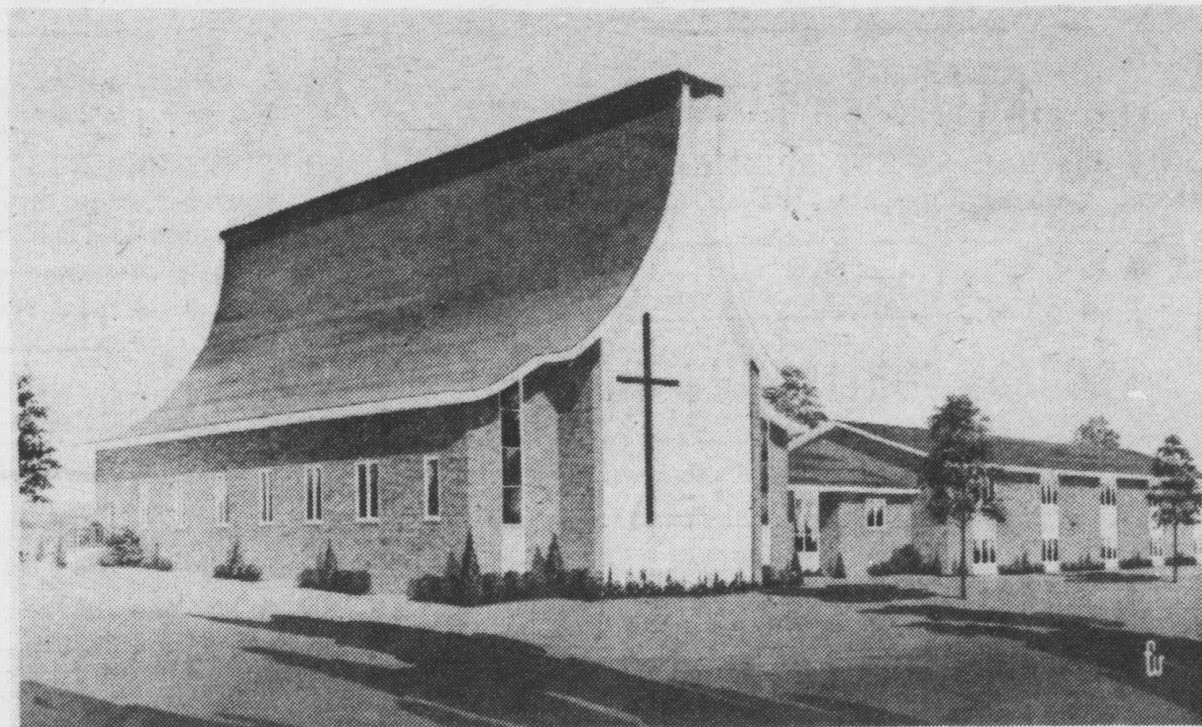
## Lung Assoc. of PA sponsors 25-mile trek
