Mr. Gerlitzki recently arrived home after spending three weeks in the hospital. He had been injured in an accident at work.

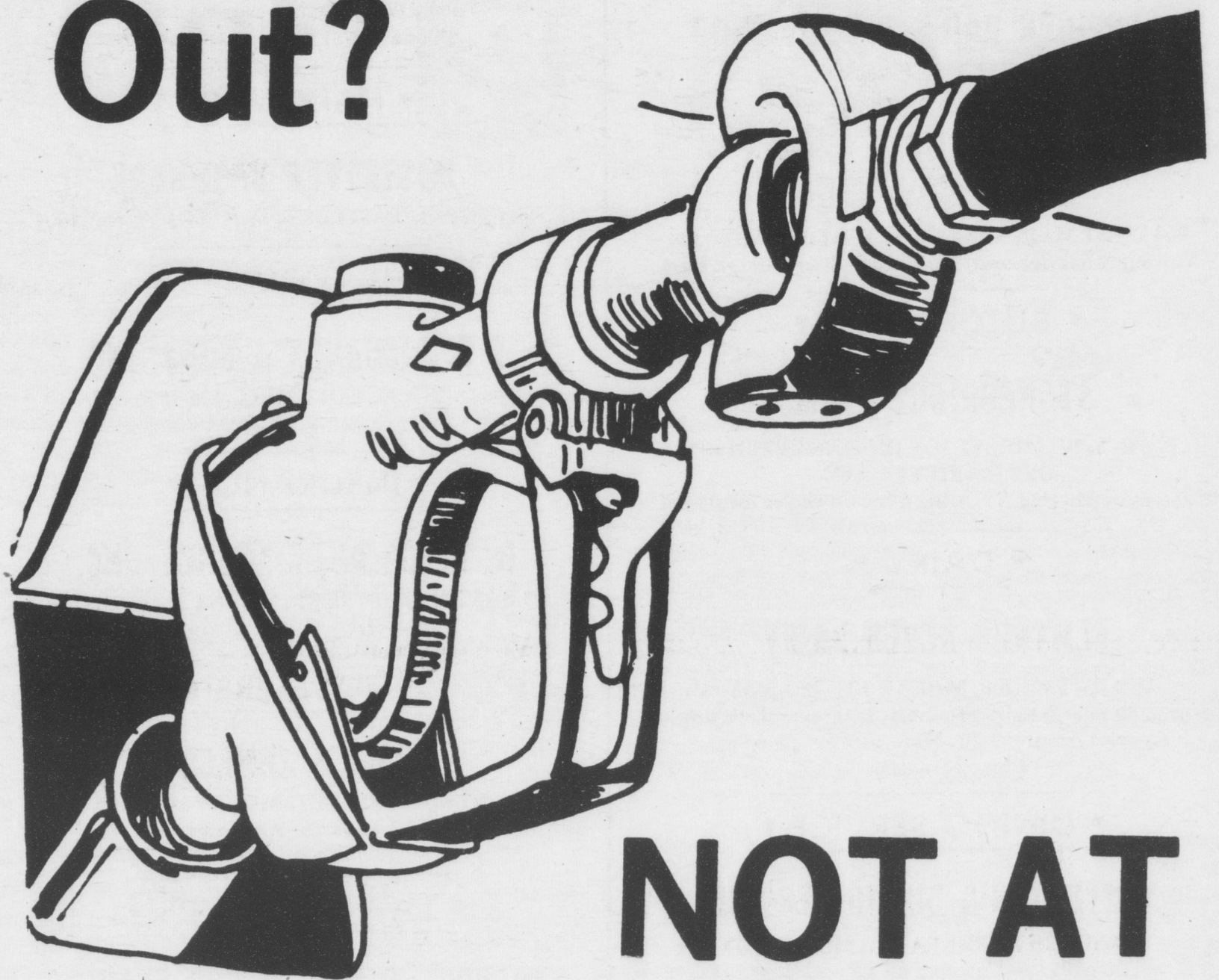
## Fund raising by W.I. Beahn chorus group

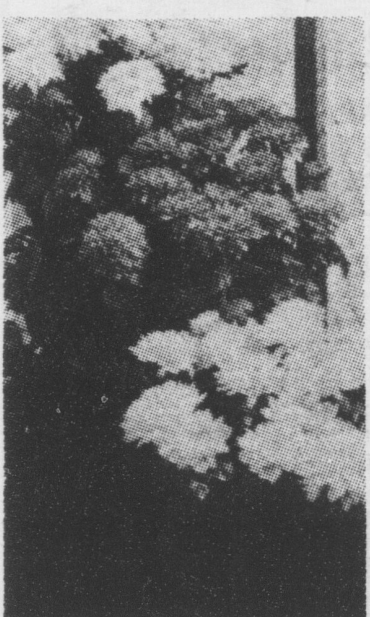
