1. Applicant must complete all (three) parts of the

application, type or print. All parts must also be signed.

2. Applications must be mailed in the yellow envelope, available from all issuing agents, to Lancaster, PA 17602. When more than one application is submitted in one envelope, all applications must be completed correctly or all

will be rejected.

3. Remit \$3.35, \$6.70 or \$10.05 depending on the number of applications, by one check or money orderno cash-payable to the County Treasurer.

4. Enclose the required green return envelope (available from the issuing agents) stamped and selfaddressed. When more than one application is submitted in one envelope, only one return envelope is required. If the return envelope is not enclosed, no license will be issued. The application and check will be filed in the treasurer's office and will have to be reclaimed by the applicant.


5. Applications must be mailed and may not be received in the Treasurer's Office before Monday, October 6, 1980.
